Key West Bight Operations:

- Bath House Renovations project to be bid in February for construction out of season.
- Allied General Contractors to provide pricing for the Old Fish Market renovation under the General Construction Services contract.
- Holiday Lighting installation to begin week of November 14th.
- Thompson Fish House Wall Restoration going to CRA for award to DN Higgins, Inc.
- Waterfront Brewery has started installation of new loading dock as part of their Major Development Plan.

Key West Bight Marina:

- October transient dockage was up 33% compared to last October.
- Began installation of the new Veeder Root spill containment system at the Ferry Terminal
- The Marina was full for Fantasy Fest.
- The Marina is full for the powerboat races from November 9th to 13th.
- 14,493 passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this October compared to 15,113 last October.
- New Wi-Fi was installed in the marina. OnSpot is the new Wi-Fi supplier.

Priorities for the Upcoming Month

- Finish installing the fuel dock sign
- Install Veeder Root fuel tank monitoring system at the Ferry Terminal.
