A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF 10 PARK BENCHES AND 20 DUAL TRASH RECEPTACLES FROM SWARTZ ASSOCIATES, INC. PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY PIGGYBACKING ON THE MANATEE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT ITB #16-0025-MR, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$61,700.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, staff obtained price quotes, including government contract quotes, from several vendors, and the Key West Bight Board recommended approval of the purchase at its meeting of November 9, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an exemption to competitive bid requirements, and the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$61,700.00 to Swartz Associates, Inc. for 10 Park Benches and 20 Dual Trash Receptacles for the Key West Historic Seaport, is hereby approved, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That budgeted funds from the Key West Bight accounts #405-7504-575-6400, #405-7505-575-6400 and #405-7506-575-6400 will be used for this purchase.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
