A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING A TWO-YEAR RENEWAL OF
THE CONTRACT FOR PORT AND MARINA SECURITY (KEY
WEST BIGHT AND FERRY TERMINAL) BETWEEN THE
CITY AND RALONS SECURITY, LLC; PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 14-043, the CRA awarded the bid and authorized a three-year contract between the City and Northstar Security, Inc. for port and marina security services; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-335, the City Commission approved the assignment of the contract to Ralons Security, LLC which purchased NorthStar Security, Inc., and acquired necessary licenses to operate within the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends a two-year extension of the contract, upon negotiated terms; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a two-year extension, as described in Section 14 of the Contract with Ralons Security, LLC, is hereby approved, including adjusted rates, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney (Key West Bight and Ferry Terminal).

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
