An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Royal Poinciana tree**. A site inspection was done on November 15, 2016 and documented the following:

This application does not have a signature from the property owner and there is not a signed and notarized letter of representative authorization signed by the property owner allowing Mark Gushiken to represent them, Therefore, this application can not be accepted for processing.

Sec. 110-323. Application.

All applications for a tree removal permit shall be made to the Urban Forestry Manager. The application shall include an inventory of all existing trees in the area of proposed construction impact, including ingress to and egress from this area. The inventory shall state size, diameter and species of each tree. In order for the application to be acted upon, it must be signed by the property owner, or a notarized letter from the property owner must be attached to the application designating an authorized agent. The applicant shall be responsible for clearly marking the subject trees on the site with flagging tape.

Dear Members of Tree Commission:

Kindly be advised that I represent Felix and Juanita Petitt, the owners of the mature Royal Poinciana tree located at 913 White Street. We have been advised that the owners of property next door to ours, Bernard Hecht and Timothy McLane, have applied to the Tree Commission for the removal of my client's tree. My clients not only object strenuously to the removal of their tree but they are perplexed as to why someone who does not own the tree can apply for removal of the tree and have that application considered by the Tree Commission when the owner of the tree does not consent to removal of the tree. Section 110-323 of the City's Code of Ordinances requires that an application for tree removal "must be signed by the property owner, or a notarized letter from the property owner must be attached to the application designating an authorized agent." The Tree Commission will be considering an application that on its face does not comply with the clear requirements of the City Code.

To be clear, it is our position that the Messrs. Hecht and McLane have no legal standing to apply for the removal of my client's royal poinciana tree and that the Tree Commission has no jurisdiction to consider removal of the tree in the absence of my clients written consent.
