1) Police Athletic League (PAL) building -

a) Discussion to include extending the area of the Horse Stables' corral to the far side of the property. No Comment

b) Discuss a request for the installation of 6 Pickleball Courts on the front lawn of the property, as the local association is looking to expand the sport to include kids and young adults, and to continue with their tournaments - which include out-of-town visitors. No Comment. In conflict with Master Plan calling for a multi-purpose field in that area.

## 2) Amphitheater -

a) What are the plans to keep the noise level down to an acceptable level? Amphitheater location (at the far end of the park) and orientation (out to sea to the southwest) was established in the Master Plan based on minimizing noise. Half shell design will direct sound to the southwest, away from Bahama Village and Tampoa. Events will be required to file a permit with the City where noise considerations (operating hours, etc.) can be addressed.

b) What if any traffic control and parking is being discussed by the city at this point? Parking will be available in paved lots throughout the park and the grassed parking area across from the Amphitheater. Traffic control will be addressed on a case by case basis (e.g., Keys stock, boat races, Ocean fest, etc.).
