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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF REY WEST, PLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "SUBMERGED LANDS LEASE" FOR CITY-OWERD STEELERSHED LANDS IN SPECIFON BIGHT ADJACENT TO 711-717 EISENECKER DRIVE BETHERN THE CITY AND ISLAND PRANQUILITY, INC.; PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIVE DAME.

SUBMERGED LANDS LEASE

THIS LEASE is bereby issued by the City of Key West, Florids, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the Lessor.

WITNESSETH: That for end in consideration of payment of the annual losse fees hereinafter provided and the faithful and timely performance of and compliance with all terms and conditions stated herein, the Lesser does hereby lesse to Island Tranquility, Inc., whose riperian upland property is located at 711-717 Eisenhower Drive Key West, Florida 33040 hereinafter referred to as the Lessee, the submerged lands described as follows:

A percel of submerged land in Section 33,

Township 67 South, Range 25 Hast, in Monroe County,

Containing approximately 15,740 equare feet,

more particularly described and shown on Attachment A

which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

It is acknowledged and understood that a portion of the fael
dock is built upon land that was filled prior to the building of the
dock. Therefore the fuel dock and improvements as shown on the attached sketch are the
property of the Leance and not part of the leased premises.

TO HAVE THE USE OF the hereinabove described premises for a period of five (5) years from September 3 ____, 2014, the effective date of this lease. The terms and conditions on and for which this lease is gramed are as follows:

- 1. <u>USE OF PROPERTY:</u> The Lessee is hereby authorized to operate a commercial docking facility with rental of wet alips, rental of recreational pleasure craft, leading/offloading passengers for charter/tour boats, to be used exclusively in conjunction with the upland use, with finding facilities, with a sewage pumpout facility (only if a pumpout facility is required by a Governmental agency, the parties acknowledge that the present use does not require a pumpout facility) if it meets the regulatory requirements of the State of Florida Department of Health, or City of Key West Ordinance whichever agency has jurisdiction, and without livesboards as defined in paragraph 26 hereof.
- 2. LEASE FEES: The Leasee bereby agrees to pay to the Lessor an initial annual lease fee of \$.166469 per square foot and 25 percent surcharge, plus sales tax pursuant to Section 212.031, Florida Statutes, if applicable, within 30 days of receipt of this fully executed lease. The annual fee for the remaining years of this lease shall be adjusted pursuant to provisions of Rule 18-21.011, Florida Administrative Code. The Lessor will notify the Lessee in writing of the amount and the doe date of each subsequent annual lease payment during the remaining term of this lease. All lease fees due beremder shall be ramitted to the Leaser. The initial annual lease fee without the supplemental payment is as follows:

- 3. WET SLIP RENTAL CERTIFICATION/SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENT: (A) The Lessee shall provide upon request by the Leaser any and all information in a certified form moded to calculate the lease fee specified in paragraph two (2) above, including the income, as defined in subsection 18-21.003(31), Ploride Administrative Code, derived directly from the losse of wet alips over submerged lands on an annual basis. Without limiting the furuguing it is animowledged that the sevence derived from the sale of gasoline, food, beverage, bait, tackle or other items sold from the facility on the facil dock shall not constitute income for the purposes of runt under this Lease. When six percent (6%) of said annual iricama exceeds the base fac or minimum assumi for established gunsuant to Rule 18-21.011, Florida Administrative Code, for any losse year during the term of this lesse, the Lesser shell tend the Lesses a supplemental invoice for the difference in the antownts for that leave year. (B) The instrument or agreement weed by the Leaves to transfer or assign the right to use a wet slip at the docking finitity to a third party shall include a provision that electly notifies the wet slip restociocosholder that if the wet alip remesfuscibolder subsequently transfers his right to use said wet alip to snother party, the instrument or exceement used to transfer said wet allo shall contain a provision that requires six percent (6%) of the annual press income derived from sold instrument or agreement for the use of sold wet slip by paid to the Lesser who, upon receipt shall report and transmit said amount to the Lesser. The instrument or agreement used by the Lessee to transfer a wet slip shall also include a provision that closely notifies the wet elip senterfeser/holder that no interest in sold wet slip may be further transferred unless a substantially similar provides to the one contained in the preceding sentence is placed in each succeeding instrument or agreement used to transfer sald wat slip to each new wat slip renter/unarcholder. (C) The Lence shall enhant to the Lessor each instrument or agreement used by the Lessos to transfer or assign the right to osc a wet slip at the docking facility to a third party samually at the same time the Lesses submits the required Annual Wet Slip Rovenue Report to the Lessne.
- 4. LATE FER ASSESSMENTS: The Lesses shall pay a late payment assessment for lease fees or other charges due under this lesse which are not paid within 30 days after the due date. This assessment shall be computed at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per summ, calculated on a daily basis for every day the payment is late.
- 5. EXAMINATION OF LESSIE'S RECORDS: For purposes of this lesse, the Lesser is hereby specifically authorized and empowered to examine, for the term of this lesse including any entensions thereto plus three (3) additional years, at all reasonable hours, the books, records, contracts, and other documents confirming and pertaining to the computation of annual lesse payments at specified in puragraph two (2) above.
- 6. MAINTENANCE OF LESSEE'S RECORDS: The Lessee shall maintain separate accounting records for: (i) the gross revenue derived directly from the use of wet elips on the lessed posmices. The Lessee shall secure, maintain and loten all records for the entire term of this lesse plus three (3) additional years. This period shall be extended for an additional two (2) years upon request for examination of all records and accounts for lesse verification purposes by the Lessor.
- 7. AGREEMENT TO EXTENT OF USE: This lease is given to the Lessee to use or occupy the leased premises only for those solivities specified barein and as conditioned by the Lesser. The Lesser shall not (i) change or add to the approved use of the lessed premises as defined herein; (ii) change activities in any manner that may have an onvironmental impact; or (iii) change the type of use of the riputan uplands or as permitted by the Lessee's interest in the riputan upland property that is more particularly described as the street address shown in Attachment A without first obtaining, the Lesser's written authorization, which authorization shall not be unreasonably withheld, in the farm of a modified lease, the poyment of additional fora, if applicable, and, if applicable, the removal of any structures which may no longer quality for authorization under the modified lease.

- 8. PROPERTY RIGHTS: The Lessee shall make no claim of title or interest to said lands hereinbefore described by reason of the occupancy or use thereof, and all title and interest to said land hereinbefore described is vested in the Lesser. The Lessee is prohibited from including, or making any claim that purports to include, said lands described or the Lessee's lessehold interest in said lands into any form of private ownership, including but not limited to any form of condominium or cooperative ownership. The Lessee is further prohibited from making any claim, including any advertisement, that said land, or the use thereof, may be purchased, sold, or re-sold. Lesser acknowledges and agrees that the fuel dock and all uplands, buildings, and improvements inside the survey line which marks the boundary of the submerged land lesse as shown on Attachment A are the sole property of the Lessee.
- 9. INTEREST IN RIPARIAN UPLAND PROPERTY: During the term of this lesse, the Lessee shall maintain satisfactory evidence of sufficient upland interest as required by paragraph 18-21.004(3)(b). Florida Administrative Code, in the riparian upland property that is more particularly described as the street address shown in Attachment A and by reference made a part hereof together with the riparian rights appartment thereto. If such interest is terminated or the Lessor determines that each interest did not exist on the effective date of this lesse, this lesse may be terminated at the option of the Lessor. If the Lessor terminates this lesse, the Lessoe approx not to aspert a claim or defense against the Lessor satisfie out of this lesse. Prior to sale and/or termination of the Lessoe's interest in the riparian upland property, the Lessoe shall inform any potential buyer or transferse of the Lessoe's interest in the riparian upland property and the existence of this lesse and all its terms and conditions and shall complete and execute any documents required by the Lessor to effect an assignment of this lesse, if consented to by the Lessor, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld by the Lessor. Failure to do so will not relieve the Lessoe from responsibility for full compliance with the terms and conditions of this lesse which include, but are not limited to, payment of all fore and/or penalty assessments incurred prior to each act.
- 10. ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE: This lease shall not be ensigned or otherwise transferred without prior written consent of the Lesser, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. Such assignment or other transfer shall be subject to the terms, conditions and provisions of this lease, current management standards and applicable laws, rules and regulations in effect at that time. Any assignment or other transfer without prior written consent of the Lesser shall be sull and void and without legal effect.
- 11. INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE: To the fullest extent pennitted by law, Lessee expressly agrees to indemnify and hold hamless the City of Key West and their respective officers, directurs, agents, and employees (herein called the "Indemnitees") from any and all liability for damages, including, if allowed by law, reasonable attorney's fees and court costs, such legal expenses to include costs incurred in establishing the indemnification and other rights agreed to in this Paragraph, to persons or property caused in whole or in part by any act, emission, or default by Lessee or its subcontractors, material men, or agents of any tier or their employees, arising out of this Lesse or its performance, including any such damages caused in whole or in part by any act, emission, or default of any indemnitee, but specifically excluding any claims of, or damages against an indemnitee resulting from such indemnitee's gress negligence, or the willful, wanton or intentional miscondect of such indemnitee or for atstutory violation or punitive damages except and to the extent the statutory violation or punitive damages are caused by or result from the acts or amissions of Lessee or its subcontractors, material page, or agents of any tier or their respective employees.

The indemnification obligations under this Lease shall not be restricted in any way by any limitation on the amount or type of damages, compensation, or benefits payable by or for Lease under workers' compensation acts, disability benefits acts, or other employes benefits acts, and shall extend to and include any actions brought by or in the name of any employee of Leaseo or of any third party to whom Lease may subcontract work. This indemnification shall cominue beyond the date of termination of the Agreement.

Lesson agrees that Lessor is not in any way an insurer of Lesson's vessel(s), property, family, invitoes, employees, agents, passengers or guests. Lesson hereby agrees to maintain and pay for a marine insurance policy providing such protection and indemnity throughout the term of this Agreement. Said policy of protection and indemnity shall protect Lessor and Lesson from all liability for injury to any persons or property

which may arise in connection with the operation of or conduct of Lessee or its vessel(s), equipment, agents, invitees, passengers, guests or employees.

Lessee hareby agrees to maintain and pay for, and provide current Certificate of Insurance at all times evidencing the following coverages:

Protection & Indemnity limits of a minimum of \$1,000,000 Per Occurrence.

Removal of Wrock coverage included in Protection & Indemnity limit

Vessel Pollution Coverage included in a minimum amount of \$800,000

Crew coverage as required by the Federal Jones Act as applicable

Any other insurance coverage as required by law

Lessor as certificate holder for purposes of notification of cancellation, termination, or renewal.

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Lesser listed as Additional Insured.

12. NOTICES/COMPLIANCE/TERMINATION: The Lesses binds itself, its successors and assigns, to shide by the provisions and conditions berein set forth, and said provisions and conditions shall be deemed covenants of the Lessee, its successors and assigns. In the event the Lessee fails or refuses to comply with the provisions and conditions herein set forth, or in the event the Lessee violates any of the provisions and conditions havein set forth, and the Lessee fails or refuces to comply with any of said provisions or conditions within twenty (20) days of receipt of the Lesson's notice to correct, this lease may be terminated by the Lesson upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Losson. If exaceled, all of the shows-described parcel of land shall revert to the Lesson. All notices required to be given to the Lesson by this Lesso or applicable law or administrative rules shall be sufficient if sent by Certified U.S. Mail to the following address: 711 Eisenhower Dr. Key West, FL 33040

The Lessee shall notify the Lessor by certified mail of any change to this andress at least ten (10) days before the change is effective.

- 13. TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS: The Leuce shall assume all responsibility for liabilities that source to the subject property or to the improvements thereon, including my and all drainage or special assessments or taxes of every kind and description which are now or may be hereafter lawfully assessed and levied against the subject property during the effective period of this lease.
- 14. NUISANCES OR ILLEGAL OPERATIONS: The Lessee shall not permit the lessed premises or any part thereof to be used or occupied for any purpose or business other than herein specified unless such proposed use and occupancy are consented to by the Lessor and the lesse is modified accordingly, nor shall Lessee knowingly permit or suffer any nuisances or illegal operations of any kind on the lessed premises.
- 15. MAINTENANCE OF FACILITY/RIGHT TO INSPECT: The Lessee shall maintain the lessed premises in good condition, keeping the structures and equipment located thereon in a good state of repair in the interests of public health, safety and welfare. No dock or pier shall be constructed in any manner that would came hann to wildlife. The leased premises shall be subject to inspection by the Leaser or its designated agent at any reasonable time.
- 16. NON-DISCRIMINATION: The Lessee shall not discriminate against any individual because of that individual's race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, handlesp, or merital status with respect to any activity occurring within the area subject to this lease or upon lands adjacent to and used as an adjunct of the lossed area.
- 17. ENFORCEMENT OF PROVISIONS: No failure, or successive failures, on the part of the Lessor to enforce any provision, nor any waiver or successive waivers on its part of any provision barein, shall operate as a discharge thereof or render the same inoperative or impair the right of the Lossor to enforce the same upon any renewal thereof or in the event of subsequent breach or breaches.

- 18. PERMISSION GRANTED: Upon expiration or cancellation of this base all permission granted because and terminate.
- 19. RENEWAL PROVISIONS: Renewal of this lone shall be subject to the City consent, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. Such renewal shall be subject to the terms, conditions and provisions of management standards and applicable laws, rules and regulations in effect at that time. In the event that the Lessoe is in full compliance with the terms of this lesse, the Lessor will begin the renewal process. The term of any renewal granted by the Lessor shall commence on the last day of the previous lesse term. In the event the Lessor does not grant a renewal, the Lessoe shall varies the lessod premises and remove all structures and equipment occupying and erected thereon at its expense. The chilgation to remove all structures sutherized herein upon termination of this lesse shall constitute an affirmative coverant upon the Lessoe's interest in the riperian upland property more particularly described as the struct address shown in Attachment A, which shall run with the title to the Lessoe's interest in said riparian upland property and shall be binding upon the Lessoe and the Lessoe's successors in title or successors in interest.
- 20. REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES/ADMINISTRATIVE FINES: If the Lesses does not remove said structures and equipment occupying and erected upon the lessed promises after expiration or cancellation of this lesse, such structures and equipment will be deemed forfeited to the Lessor, and the Lessor may authorize removal and may sell such forfeited structures and equipment after ten (10) days written notice by certified mail addressed to the Lessee at the address specified in Paragraph 12 or at such address on record as provided to the Lesser by the Lessee. However, such remody shall be in addition to all other remodies available to the Lesser under applicable laws, rules and regulations including the right to compel removal of all structures and the right to impose administrative fines.
- 21. REMOVAL COSTS/LIEN ON RIPARIAN LPLAND PROPERTY: Subject to the noticing provisions of Paragraph 20 of this lease, any costs incurred by the Lessor in removal of any structures and equipment constructed or maintained on state lands shall be paid by Lessoe and any unpaid costs and expenses shall constitute a lien upon the Lessoe's interest in the riparian upland property that is more particularly described as the street address shown in Attachment A. This lien on the Lessoe's interest in the riparian upland property shall be enforceable in summary proceedings as provided by law.
- 22. <u>RIPARIAN RIGHTS/FINAL ADJUDICATION</u>: In the event that any part of any structure authorized hereunder is determined by a final adjudication issued by a court of competent jurisdiction to encreach on or interfere with adjacent signal nights, Lease agrees to either obtain written consent for the offending structure from the affected signals owner or to remove the interference or encreachment within 60 days from the date of the adjudication. Failure to comply with this paragraph shall constitute a material breach of this lease agreement and shall be grounds for immediate termination of this lease agreement at the option of the Leaser.
- 23. AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS: This Lease is the entire and only agreement between the parties. Its provisions are not severable. Any amendment or modification to this lease must be in writing, must be accepted, acknowledged and concaind by the Lesson and Lessor, and must comply with the rules and statutes in existence at the time of the execution of the modification or amendment. Notwithstanding the provisions of this paragraph, if mooring is authorized by this lease, the Lesson may install boatlifts within the leased premises without formal modification of the lease provided that (a) the Lesson obtains any state or local regulatory permit that may be required; and (b) the location or size of the lift does not increase the mooring especity of the docking facility.
- 24. ADVERTISEMENT/SIGNS/NON-WATER DEPENDENT ACTIVITIES/ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES/MINOR STRUCTURAL REPAIRS: No permanent or temporary signs directed to the boating public advertising the sale of elecholic boverages shall be erected or placed within the leased premises. No restaurant or dising activities are to occur within the leased premises. The Lease shall ensure that no permanent, temporary or floating structures, fences, docks, pilings or any structures whose use is not water-dependent shall be erected or conducted over submerged lands without prior written consent from the Leasor, which consent may withheld by Leasor in Leasor's sole discretion. No additional structures end/or activities

including dredging, relocation/realignment or major repairs or removations to authorized structures, shall be erected or conducted on or over the submerged lands without prior written consent from the Lessor, which consent may be withheld by Lessor in Lessor's sole discretion. Unless specifically authorized in writing by the Lessor, such activities or structures shall be considered unauthorized and a breach of this Lesse. This condition does not apply to minor structural repairs required to maintain the authorized structures in a good state of repair in the interests of public health, safety or welfare; provided, however, that such activities shall not exceed the activities authorized by this Lesso. Notwithstanding the foregoing the Lessor acknowledges that the existing usage as a Marina and Restaurant, including but not limited to the sale of alcoholic beverages, food, signage, on the Lessoes upland property are allowed under the terms of this Lesso.

- 25. COMPLIANCE WITH FLORIDA LAWS: On or in conjunction with the use of the leased premises, the Lessee shall at all times comply with all Florida Statutes and all administrative rules promulgated thereunder. Any unlawful activity which occurs on the leased premises or in conjunction with the use of the leased premises shall be grounds for the termination of this Lesse by the Lessor.
- 26. LIVEABOARDS: The term "livesboard" is defined as a vessel docked at the facility and inhabited by a person or persons for any five (5) consecutive days or a total of ten (10) days within a thirty (30) day period. If livesboards are authorized by paragraph one (1) of this lease, in no event shall such "livesboard" status exceed six (6) months within any twelve (12) month period, nor shall any such vessel constitute a legal or primary residence.
- 27. GAMBLING VESSHIS: During the term of this Lease and any renewals, extensions, modifications or assignments thereof, Lease chall prohibit the operation of or entry onto the leased premises of gambling cruise ships, or vessels that are used principally for the purpose of gambling, when these vessels are engaged in "cruises to nowhere," where the ships leave and return to the state of Florida without an intervening stop within another state or foreign country, and any watercraft used to carry passengers to and from such gambling cruise ships.
- 28. FINANCIAL CAPARILITY: To assure the Lesser that the Lessee has the financial capability to undertake and operate the project authorized by this lesse, the Lessee certifies to the Lesser as follows: (i) the Lessee is not the subject of a paniing bankuptery proceeding; (ii) the Lessee has no unsatisfied judgments entered against it; (iii) the Lessee has satisfied all state and local taxes for which it is responsible; and (iv) no other matters are pending or threatened against or affecting the Lessee or the Lessee's interest in the riperian upland property that would impair the Lessee's financial capability to undertake and operate the project authorized by this lesse. Any breach of this lesse condition shall constitute a definit under this lesse.

30. SPECIAL LEASE CONDITION(S):
