

RE: Administrative Hearing, 1017 Windsor Lane

On September 9, 2016, it was noticed that a tree located at the corner of the building near the driveway area was missing. During this time there had been a discussion with others regarding the species of tree and whether it was regulated or not. Before a final determination of species could be made, the tree was documented as removed. The removal of the tree would have required a removal permit since the diameter was over 4" dbh. It is thought the tree was a white geiger or similar type of tree. It appears the tree was removed when the fence was installed. It is not know who removed the tree.

A warning letter was sent to the property owners on November 14, 2016. No response was received.

The approximate caliper of the tree was 9" based on measurement taken of the stump.

Recommend replanting a minimum of 9 caliper inches of approved trees on the property.
