SUBJECT: Florida Public Art Professionals Association Annual Conference

ACTION STATEMENT

Consider the details of travel to the annual FAPAP Conference, April 19-21, 2017 in Orlando to determine the number of attendees and additional logistics. Please see the attached draft Conference Agenda.

BACKGROUND

The host hotel is the Embassy Suites with a conference rate of \$150 per night. A 7 passenger vehicle at the City's rate will be \$55/day, the drive time to Orlando is approximately seven (7) hours. Registration begins at 9:30am on Wednesday 4/19 and the Welcome Session begins at 12:30pm. The final activity for the Conference is a Public Art Tour beginning at 1pm on Friday 4/21. It should be anticipated that we would drive as a group, departing from Key West in the afternoon of the 18th or the early morning hours of the 19th, and returning in the evening on the 21st. Meals not included in the Conference would be reimbursed at the following per diem rates: Breakfast \$7, Lunch \$11, and Dinner \$18. Gas would be reimbursable in accordance with the City's Travel Policy. Registration for the Conference is \$125 for Designated Institutional Members and \$150 for Individual Members. It is time to renew the City of Key West AIPP Institutional Membership and those members who plan to attend will be listed as Designated Institutional Members under the City of Key West AIPP Membership.

PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION

This state-wide professional conference is a networking opportunity for those engaged in the field of Public Art. It provides insights into trends, innovations, and opportunities for Public Art programs and Public Artists.

Members of the AIPP Board of Directors have attended previous year's FAPAP Conferences and reported valuable experiences which have contributed to their insights as advisors to the City Commission.

Monroe County has successfully hosted the Conference in a previous year and our participation is considered valuable by the larger FAPAP community.
