Agenda Item:

A proposed ordinance amending the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, Chapter 3, Policy 3-1.1.8; providing for severability; providing for repeal of inconsistent provisions, providing for an effective date.

Action Item / Background

The City Attorney's Office, in conjunction with the Housing Authority of Key West, completed an audit/enforcement program in 2016 to compel better compliance by property owners with the annual reporting requirements of the affordable workforce housing ordinance in sections 122-1465 through 122-1469.

The results of these efforts were presented to the City Commission at its regular meeting of December 6, 2016 together with suggested modifications of the ordinances designed to improve compliance and enforcement.

The City Commission directed the City Attorney's Office to bring the proposed ordinance revisions forward resulting in this item.

An amendment to Chapter 3 of the City of Key West Comprehensive Land Use Plan is needed in order for the Comprehensive Plan to be consistent with the proposed amendment to the land development regulations. The amendment to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan eliminates the one year residency requirement found in Chapter 3, Policy 3-1.1.8.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Attorney's office recommends that the City Commission **approve** the amendment to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan.
