A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) AWARDED THE BID OF RAVENS MARINE, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,713.00, FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO FLOATING DOCKS WITH GANGWAYS FOR THE KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THEIR RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #17-016; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 15, 2017, the Key West Bight Board recommended approval of this item; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Ravens Marine, Inc. for Two Floating Docks with Gangways for the Key West Historic Seaport, in the total amount not to exceed \$25,713.00, is hereby awarded in accordance with the terms and conditions in ITB #17-016 and response thereto.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: Funds for this project are budged in account #405-7503-575-6300 (KB75031601).

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
