This document draws primarily upon previous inventories conducted by the AIPP Program in both 2011 and 2013, as well as the 2014 Annual Report. This inventory document is not final and should not be considered to be a completely comprehensive list at this time. It does, however, reflect the breadth and wealth of Public Art in the Key West Community. The Administrator has not verified that all installations listed here are currently in existence as described. An AIPP Ordinance has been a part of the City of Key West's Municipal Code of Ordinances since 1986; however, the 1% requirement was not implemented until 2011, and was finalized in its current format in January 2016 (Division 8, Sec 2-487).

Memorial Sculpture at Vietnam Veterans Memorial Park: 2014, donated by Ed Knight, bronze sculpture of Black Civil War Soldier- "Forgotten Soldiers of the Civil War", adjacent to Vietnam Veterans Memorial at Bayview Park.
