A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK UNDER THE CITY'S **ENVIRONMENTAL** ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TETRA TECH. TOTAL NOT IN Α AMOUNT TO EXCEED \$86,035.00 FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN COSTS AND CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE REST BEACH STABILIZATION PROJECT TO ENSURE PROPER INSTALLATION OF SEAWALL AND THAT ALL PROVISIONS OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS ARE MET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-354, the City Commission approved a three-year Environmental Engineering Services contract with Tetra Tech, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 16-066 the City Commission approved a proposal from Tetra Tech to provide Planning, Engineering, Design and Permitting to armor the sloped shoreline along Rest Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental

Protection (FDEP) required certain permit modifications and

redesign of the project, and City staff requested Tetra Tech to

prepare a fee proposal for additional design services to

complete construction plans and bid documents, along with fees

for CEI services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a work order for additional design services, along with CEI services, for the Rest Beach stabilization project, under the City's Environmental Engineering Services Contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$86,035.00.

Section 2: This project will be funded from account No. 101-1900-519-4600, Rest Beach Seawall (Project IS19001602).

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
