Memorial Grant – Local Solicitation in the amount of \$13,162.00.

<u>Action Statement:</u> Approve and authorize the Key West Police Department to accept a Federal grant titled 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Grant – Local Solicitation in the amount of \$13,162.00. This grant, if accepted, will allow the Police Department to purchase equipment for the effective and efficient operation of the Department within the accepted program areas of this grant.

Background: The Key West Police Department has been awarded a series of Federal grants with the Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) on a yearly basis. Past purchases in the program areas of planning, evaluation, and information technology improvement and law enforcement programs have increased the operational efficiency and effectiveness of the department. The application submission deadline for this year's Byrne Grant was September 5, 2017. This grant will fund the purchase of equipment and/or supplies within the accepted program area of law enforcement programs to enhance the operational capabilities of the department.

The grant has no matching requirement and the award consists of all Federal Funds thus increasing City revenue.

The grant application submittal and acceptance of the award are both done through the Office of Justice Programs, Department of Justice website.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> The acceptance of the grant will increase grant revenue by \$13,162.00 Account No. 001-0000-331.20-00. The expenditures for the purchase of grant eligible equipment will be budgeted in Account No. 001-2104-521.64-00 for FY 17/18.

Recommendation: We recommend the option to approve and authorize the department to accept the grant and purchase grant funded equipment.
