A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAL PROPERTIES LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST (LRA), APPROVING UCA NO. 6 FOR THE USE OF THE UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS ALLOWANCE (UCA) IN AMOUNT THE\$70,774.00 BY CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, (CTS) FOR **RE-LANDSCAPPING** SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETED AREAS WITHIN PHASE IA OF THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT PARK DUE TO HURRICANE IRMA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO EXECUTE MANAGER **NECESSARY** DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-326, the LRA awarded a bid for Truman Waterfront Park Phase 1A project to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc., for a total amount of \$17,453,752.67, inclusive of \$629,236.33 for unforeseen conditions funds; and WHEREAS, in Resolutions No. 16-220, 16-292, 17-071 and 17-284 the use of portions of the unforeseen conditions allowance has been authorized; and

WHEREAS, additional unforeseen conditions, set forth in the attached Executive Summary dated November 7, 2017, UCA No. 6, and the Work Directive Change Proposal dated November 2, 2017, to re-landscape Hurricane Irma damaged/destroyed areas, have resulted in additional unforeseen costs totaling \$70,774.00; and

WHEREAS, Landscaping is not reimbursable under FEMA regulations; however, costs associated with this UCA will be forwarded to the City's insurance carrier for possible reimbursement, or to apply to the policy deductible; and

WHEREAS, use of UCA funds in the amount of \$70,774.00 to cover UCA No. 6 will leave an available balance of \$280,168.15 in the Unforeseen Conditions Allowance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NAVAL PROPERTIES LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the use of \$70,774.00 from the Unforeseen Conditions Allowance, as described in the attached Executive Summary, UCA No. 6, and Work Directive Change Proposal dated November 2, 2017, is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That adequate unforeseen conditions funds are allocated in the project budget.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents related to the expenditures described herein, upon the advice and consent of the City

Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
