A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE BID OF CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, INC. IN RESPONSE TO CITY OF KEY WEST REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. 003-18 FOR HURRICANE IRMA - VEGETATIVE DEBRIS BURN (PROJECT HU171002) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$892,150.00; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE RFP, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Irma made landfall in Key West and the Florida Keys on September 10, 2017, causing great destruction, including approximately 102,000 cubic yards of vegetative debris currently held at a leased Temporary Debris Management Site on Rockland Key; and

WHEREAS the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has authorized disposal of vegetative debris by air curtain burning under Emergency Final Order 17-0989; and

WHEREAS, burning of vegetative debris will save taxpayers an estimated \$1,959,260 in lieu of hauling to the mainland for disposal; and

WHEREAS the City issued RFP 003-18 requesting proposals for Hurricane Irma Vegetative Debris Burn and received three responses to the RFP on November 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, at a public meeting on November 27, 2017, a Technical Review Committee, consisting of the FEMA Coordinator and representatives of Engineering Services staff, considered the proposals and costs, and recommended award of the project to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That RFP 003-18 is hereby awarded to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$892,150.00.

Section 2: This project (HU171002) shall be funded from account 001-1910-519-6500, established for Hurricane Irma recovery, and any necessary budget transfers are authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute documents in substantial conformance with the RFP, inclusive of additive alternates for additional insurance, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
