A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AN EMERGENCY TASK ORDER APPROVED BY THE CITY MANAGER AS ALLOWED UNDER SECTION 2-797(2) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES SERVICES CONTRACT WITH D.N. HIGGINS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$45,000.00 FOR REPAIR OF THE DAMAGED STORMWATER STRUCTURE AND PIPE ON FRONT STREET DUE TO A WATER MAIN BREAK; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on November 1st, 2017, an FKA water main break occurred at the corner of Front Street and Whitehead Street, and the resultant high pressure, high volume water created a sinkhole and the collapse of a city-owned stormwater structure and related pipe; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities Services contract with Douglas N. Higgins; and

WHEREAS, a fully operational stormwater structure, as well as properly graded public areas, are life safety concerns that require immediate repair, so the City Manager acted without delay, using emergency powers authorized under Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances, to procure a contract with D.N.

Higgins, at a cost not to exceed \$45,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances requires the City Commission to ratify such emergency purchases at its next scheduled meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an Emergency Task Order for Repair of Damaged Stormwater Structure and Pipe on Front Street due to water main break, under the City's General Utilities Contract with Douglas N. Higgins, Inc., is hereby ratified in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, pursuant to Section 2-797(2) of the City Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: Initial costs will be funded from stormwater account 402-3802-538-4600, and it is anticipated that funds for this project will be recovered from the responsible party, and any necessary budget adjustments are authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute necessary documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
