


An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Mahogany tree**. A site inspection was done on December 21, 2017 and documented the following:


Tree Species: Mahogany (Swietenia mahagoni)



Water meter location

























Diameter: 18.1"

Location: 20% (water line and electrical line issues-FKAA reported a leak of water line from road to house, electrical lines run through canopy and panel appears to be shifting due to roots—wrong tree wrong place) Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 40% (large old injury in main trunk, lots of hurricane damage in canopy)

Total Average Value = 53% Value x Diameter = 9.5 replacement caliper inches

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the removal of one (1) Mahogany tree at 2908 Harris Avenue to be replaced with 9.5 caliper inches of dicot or fruit trees from approved list, FL#1, to be planted on site.

This is a courtesy email to notify you that our records show that your meter indicated a continuous leak on 11/01/2017 at 2908 HARRIS AVE KEY WEST FL 33040 for account 599644-001836 on meter #1540001814.

The FKAA defines continuous leak as anytime your meter registers flow in all of the 15 minute intervals in a 24-hour period.

When these conditions exist it is a good idea to check for household leaks. Some conditions that may cause continuous flow through the meter may include a leaking toilet, a dripping faucet or spigot, or a leak in your piping or irrigation system. To: Mike & Barbara Hudgins

Re: Suspected water leak at 2908 Harris Avenue, KeyWest

I inspected your property with Mike present. Mike talked to the FKAA while I was there. I turned off the main water value at the northwest corner of the house, which is about 25' from the meter at the northwest corner of the property. I confirmed that there was no leak in the vicinity of the value or in the meter box.

Mike & I observed the movement of the meter with the valve off for about 20 minutes. We observed a small occasionally intermittent movement of the meter, which I would estimate to be in the neighborhood of 1.9 to 3 gallons per day.

Based on my experience, it is my estimate that the leak is in the main supply line to the house, between the meter and the house, and that the leak is most likely caused by pressure on that line by a root or roots of the mahogany tree. Further growth or movement will likely cause more pressure which will sooner or later break the line enough to cause a large leak and loss of water pressure to your house.

There is no charge for this inspection. Please let me know if I can be of further assistance.
