A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKING AND ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION GROUP ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING A FIFTEEN DOLLAR (\$15.00) INCREASE FOR VIOLATIONS OF SEC.70-121; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West is considering an ordinance revision to Sec. 70-121 at the January 3, 2018 City Commission meeting that calls for a Ten Dollar (\$10.00) increase for a violation of overtime parking in Sec. 70-121; and

WHEREAS, The Parking and Alternative Transportation Advisory Board voted unanimously that a \$15.00 increase is more in line with other similarly situated cities in South Florida, rather than the currently recommended \$10.00 increase for overtime parking fines; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARKING AND ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION GROUP ADVISORY BOARD FOR THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a unanimous recommendation be sent to the City Commission for the City of Key West that an amendment to Sec. 70-121 of the Code of Ordinances regarding overtime parking be made to increase the fine by \$15.00.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Advisory Board.
