



An application was received requesting the removal of **(2)** Avocado trees. A site inspection was done on January 23, 2018 and documented the following:


Tree Species: Avocado (Persea Americana)




























Diameter: 15.6" Location: 80% Species: 100% (on protected tree list) Condition: 50% (fair to poor, decay in many trunk cuts, long sprawling trunks, poor structure) Total Average Value = 76% Value x Diameter = 11.8 replacement caliper inches













Diameter: 14.9" Location: 80% Species: 100% (on protected tree list) Condition: 30% (very poor, lots of decay throughout tree, poor structure) Total Average Value = 70% Value x Diameter = 10.4 replacement caliper inches

Property states that due to health reasons, he must build a bedroom on the first floor. The only place for this construction is where these two trees are located.

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the removal of two (2) Avocado trees at 1220 South Street to be replaced with a total of 22.2 caliper inches of dicot or fruit trees from approved list, FL#1, to be planted on site.
