Ruiz said he saw a female walking back and forth inside the residence. Ruiz said the female who was walking back and forth was wearing a black backpack and possible dressed in black clothing. That female was later identified by her not valid North Carolina driver license as Jessica Ann Stumm. Ruiz also stated he smelled marijuana coming from the residence as he stood in front of the residence. Ruiz met me at 20th Street and Duck Avenue and pointed to the residence where the incident was taking place.

I walked to the residence and met with Officer Grassi and Officer Young. I heard some people talking in the residence and I then heard the door slam on the side of the residence. A white male, later identified by his Florida Identification number as Dylan Denker (Arrestee) approached us and stopped on the front the front lawn. Denker was holding a glass bottle of beer in his right hand. I asked Denker what was going on. Denker looked at us for a moment and said, "I'm going back in the house." Denker turned quickly and started to walk fast towards the side door of the residence. I yelled out loud, "No no no no no." I was able to get a hold of the back of Denker's shirt as he grabbed for the side door knob. I immediately smelled a strong odor of marijuana emanating from Denker's person. I took hold of Denker's left wrist to place him into custody reference a narcotic investigation. Officer Young took hold of Denker's right wrist. I removed the glass bottle of beer from Denker's right hand and let it drop to the ground. Once I removed my handcuffs from my duty belt, Denker aggressively moved his body and arms forward thwarting our attempts to handcuff him. Officer Young used Denker's aggressive movement forward to pin Denker into the corner of the house. In doing so Denker hit his mouth and forehead on the stucco door jamb causing a small laceration in his mouth. Once we gained control of Denker's wrists I was able to handcuff him. I escorted Denker to the front of the driveway. I explained to Denker why were at his residence. Denker subsequently told me he got scared because he was arrested a few weeks ago for a warrant and resisting without violence. I asked Denker if he had weed on him. Denker said yes and that it was in his back right pocket. I removed a small transparent plastic cellophane wrapper containing a green leafy substance of suspected marijuana from Denker's right rear pocket. I subsequently field-tested the suspected marijuana and it tested positive. I weighed the marijuana and it weighed 0.8 grams.

Sgt. Castillo recovered one half of a burnt marijuana cigarette on the stairs where we took Denker into custody. I subsequently field-tested the marijuana cigarette and it tested positive. I subsequently placed the FTP marijuana cigarette into KWPD Property for destruction.

I advised Denker of his Maranda Rights. Denker understood his rights and agreed to speak to me without a lawyer present. After a short conversation with Denker, he understood why we were there and admitted he and his Mother were having an argument. Denker said he was also appreciative that I was straight forward with him about the incident.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/28/2018, Dylan Denker did knowingly and intentionally resist officers attempts to place Denker into custody violating FSS 843.02 resist officer without violence.

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On 01/28/2018, at approximately 2038 hours, Officer Grassi, Officer Young and I, Officer Leahy responded to 3739 Duck Avenue about a domestic verbal argument and the odor of marijuana coming from the house where the argument was taking place.

KWPD Dispatch advised the reporting party, identified as Gregory Ruiz (Juvenile), said he heard two people arguing at the above address. Ruiz said he saw a female walking back and forth inside the residence. Ruiz said the female who was walking back and forth was wearing a black backpack and possible dressed in black clothing. That female was later identified by her not valid North Carolina driver license as Jessica Ann Stumm. Ruiz also stated he smelled marijuana coming from the residence as he stood in front of the residence. Ruiz met me at 20th Street and Duck Avenue and pointed to the residence where the incident was taking place.

Ruiz did not stay at scene long enough for me to get his personal information date of birth etc., but there is a phone number attached to the report. I will follow-up on my next work day and attempt to get Ruis' information.

and his Mother were having an argument. Denker said he was also appreciative that I was straight forward with him about the incident.

After an investigation was completed and Stumm's boyfriend Dylan Denker was arrested, I asked Officer Young to speak to Stumm to see if she also smelled of marijuana. Officer Young said Stumm did smell of marijuana. I had Stumm come to my location. I confirmed that Stumm smelled of marijuana. I asked Stumm for consent to search her backpack and her person. Stumm gave verbal consent to search both. Officer Grassi searched Stumm's person, while I searched Stumm's backpack. I opened the backpack and immediately observed an orange receptacle with no label. Stumm looked at the container and said she forgot it was in the backpack. The receptacle contained a small metal pipe used for smoking marijuana. I subsequently field-tested the pipe and it tested positive for marijuana. I saw another orange receptacle with a different name on the prescription label, not Stumm's. I asked Stumm if the pill container was hers and she said, "No." The container was marked as containing Lorazepam, a Schedule 4 narcotic. The receptacle contained 1 round white pill with the serial number SZ 198. I confirmed with Florida Poison Control that the pill was a 1MG Lorazepam.

Officer Grassi advised Stumm of her Miranda Rights. Stumm invoked her rights and refused to speak to her without a lawyer present.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/28/2018, Jessica Ann Stumm did knowingly and intentionally posses Lorazepam without a prescription, violating FSS 893.13 (6)(a) possession of a controlled substance without a prescription.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/28/2018, Jessica Ann Stumm did knowingly and intentionally posses a metal pipe containing FTP marijuana violating FSS 893.147 (1) possession of drug paraphernalia.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/28/2018, Dylan Denker did knowingly and intentionally resist officers attempts to place Denker into custody violating FSS 843.02 resist officer without violence.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/28/2018, Dylan Denker did knowingly and intentionally possess 0.8 grams of marijuana violating FSS| 893.13 (6)(b) possession of marijuana less than 20 grams.

The incident was captured on my BWC and in-car camera.

I transported Denker into the Monroe County Detention Center.

I collected and placed all property into KYPD Property and Evidence.

The pill will subsequently be be sent to FDLE for lab analysis.

On Sunday, January 28, 2018, at approximately 2042 hours, Officer Grassi and I, Officer J. Young, responded to 3739 Duck Ave. in reference to a verbal disturbance. Key West Communications Channel #1 gave the narrative the argument was between a male and female and the caller could smell the odor of marijuana emanating from the house.

Officer Leahy arrived on scene before Officer Grassi and I did. As I was walking up to the residence, I saw a white male, later identified as Dylan Denker by his Florida Driver's License, standing in the driveway speaking with Officer Leahy. I heard Denker say, "I'm going inside the house". I saw Denker turn and walk towards the house at a very fast pace. I heard Officer Leahy give Denker loud, verbal commands to stop. Denker did not comply and started walking faster. Officer Leahy and I caught up to Denker, in the unenclosed, carport, next to the doorway to the residence.

Officer Leahy grabbed a hold of Denker by his left arm and Officer Leahy told Denker to place his arms behind his back as I grabbed Denker's right arm. Denker had a fresh, Heineken beer in his left hand and Denker would not let go of his beer or follow Officer Leahy's verbal commands. Officer Leahy loosened his grasp to Denker's left arm to remove the beer bottle from Denker's hand and get his handcuffs.

I felt Denker lunge forward, as if to run or escape. I allowed Denker's forward momentum to work towards my advantage in gaining physical control of him. I guided Denker towards the wall of the house and Denker's face struck the stucco corner of the door jamb. I told Denker to place his hands behind his back and he still did not comply. I overpowered Denker's attempt to resist being taken into custody and Officer Leahy placed Denker in handcuffs.

I smelled Denker had an odor of burnt and unburnt marijuana on his person.

I saw small traces of blood on the wall from Denker's face and I saw him spit blood on the ground. I requested for Key West Fire / Rescue to respond to the scene to provide medical assistance to Denker. I also requested for Sgt. Castillo to respond to the scene reference the response to resistance.

I stood by as Officer Leahy further spoke with Denker and searched his person. I saw Officer Leahy remove a green leafy substance, packaged inside of a cigarette pack cellophane. This substance was field tested positive for marijuana.

Officer Leahy asked me if I smelled the odor of burnt marijuana on Denker's girlfriend, Jessica Stumm, who was present outside of the house. I spoke with Stumm, obtaining her information and I was able to smell she had an odor of burnt marijuana emanating from her person. I told Officer Leahy that I had smelled the odor of marijuana on her person and he searched her based upon my observation.

Officer Leahy located drug paraphernalia and un prescribed pill on Stumm's person. Officer Grassi handcuffed Stumm.
