On Monday, February 12, 2018, at approximately 14:00 hours, communications advised officers in the area of Kennedy Drive and North Roosevelt Blvd, to be on the lookout for a reckless driver. The vehicle was described as being a silver Ford Tempo 4-door with a Washington tag. The caller told communications that a white male or female with long hair was driving erratically, shooting "birds" with their middle finger as they passed motorists and as speeding. The caller then informed dispatch that the driver stopped the vehicle at the intersection of Kennedy Drive and North Roosevelt Blvd and got out of the silver Ford Tempo 4dr.

As I approached the area, I noted that the caller told communications that the driver got back into the vehicle and began to drive inbound on North Roosevelt Blvd, last seen making a right turn onto Palm Avenue. Communications told us that the person driving the vehicle was a suspect in a theft case at CVS Pharmacy in Stock Island.

I arrived at the intersection of Palm Avenue and North Roosevelt Boulevard and as I began to make a right onto Palm Avenue, I observed a gold, older model Ford 4-door, traveling west on North Roosevelt Blvd, veer from the inside lane, to the outside lane, then back to the inside lane, before making a left into the Circle K parking lot (First and North Roosevelt Blvd).

I pulled into the Circle K parking lot and advised dispatch that I was out with the suspect vehicle, which was parked and unoccupied at the time. I noted that the windows were halfway down and the engine running. A empty clear bottle, labeled "Bacardi" was on the front passenger seat.

I entered the store and looked around. I observed one female wearing a pink dress, who appeared to be walking around. I stood inside and watched her, since she was the only person in there at the time with long hair. Ofc. M. Malgrat and Ofc. M. Pettee arrived on scene and entered the store. I continued to keep on eye on the female, later identified as Autum Lea Bible. As officers were getting ready to leave, I saw Bible grab something off the shelf. We walked out of the store and Bible followed directly behind us. She did not attempt to pay for the item she was holding in her hand when she walked out of the store.

Bible began to walk to her vehicle to leave. I told her that she was not free to leave and not to get into her vehicle. She refused to comply and kept trying to get to the vehicle. Ofc. Pettee took Bible's arm to prevent her from getting into the vehicle. At that point, Bible began to pull away and scream. I told her again that she was not free to leave and she continued to pull away from Ofc. Pettee and Ofc. Malgrat, who stepped in to take Bible's left arm. Bible began screaming and pulling away from Ofc. Pettee and Ofc. Malgrat. She resisted having handcuffs put on her and began to push backwards using her buttocks, all the while attempting to pull away from the two officers. The handcuffs were applied and Bible was escorted to my vehicle. As Ofc. Malgrat and Ofc. Pettee passed the front end of my patrol vehicle, Bible put her right foot up on the front bumper and pushed back in an attempt to keep officers from moving her toward the back of the car. She refused to remove her foot from the car and continued to push backward. Ofc. Pettee swept her right leg from the front of the car, which caused Bible to go down to the ground onto both knees. She was brought back up to her feet and was being escorted to the right rear of my car when she began to push against the officers. Bible's upper body was put over the front of my car in order to control her as Ofc. Pettee attempted to unlock the door. Bible at this point, picked up her left leg, kicked back and struck Ofc. M. Malgrat on his left knee and thigh. Ofc. Malgrat did not complain of any pain, but the area may bruise later on. Ofc. Pettee took Bible's right arm and directed her to the ground. Bible sustained abrasions to her right face and both knees.

Sgt. J. Williamson and Key West Fire Department EMS (R5) were requested at the scene for evaluation and treatment of Bible. Monroe County Sheriffs Deputies A. Davis and K. Fricke arrived on scene to continue

their investigation.

I searched Bible's purse, which contained numerous items with price tags. A dress, which was described to Dep. Davis by CVS employees, was located in the front seat of the car. The dress was turned over to Dep. Davis. The two cookies removed from Circle K by Bible (\$1.29 and .99, respectively), were turned back over to Circle K employees. Tiffany Lee, employee at Circle K, provided me with a security video showing Bible take the items and walk out of the store. It also partially shows Bible resisting officers at the front door (outside).

Bible was transported to the Monroe County Detention Center by Dep Davis. The items removed from Bibles purse were also turned over to Dep. Davis.

As I approached the area, I noted that the caller told communications that the driver got back into the vehicle and began to drive inbound on North Roosevelt Blvd, last seen making a right turn onto Palm Avenue. Communications told us that the person driving the vehicle was a suspect in a theft case at CVS Pharmacy in Stock Island.

I arrived at the intersection of Palm Avenue and North Roosevelt Boulevard and as I began to make a right onto Palm Avenue, I observed a gold, older model Ford 4-door, traveling west on North Roosevelt Blvd, veer from the inside lane, to the outside lane, then back to the inside lane, before making a left into the Circle K parking lot (First and North Roosevelt Blvd).

I pulled into the Circle K parking lot and advised dispatch that I was out with the suspect vehicle, which was parked and unoccupied at the time. I noted that the windows were halfway down and the engine running. A empty clear bottle, labeled "Bacardi" was on the front passenger seat.

I entered the store and looked around. I observed one female wearing a pink dress, who appeared to be walking around. I stood inside and watched her, since she was the only person in there at the time with long hair. Ofc. M. Malgrat and Ofc. M. Pettee arrived on scene and entered the store. I continued to keep on eye on the female, later identified as Autum Lea Bible. As officers were getting ready to leave, I saw Bible grab something off the shelf. We walked out of the store and Bible followed directly behind us. She did not attempt to pay for the item she was holding in her hand when she walked out of the store.

Bible began to walk to her vehicle to leave. I told her that she was not free to leave and not to get into her vehicle. She refused to comply and kept trying to get to the vehicle. Ofc. Pettee took Bible's arm to prevent her from getting into the vehicle. At that point, Bible began to pull away and scream. I told her again that she was not free to leave and she continued to pull away from Ofc. Pettee and Ofc. Malgrat, who stepped in to take Bible's left arm.

Bible began screaming and pulling away from Ofc. Pettee and Ofc. Malgrat. She resisted having handcuffs put on her and began to push backwards using her buttocks, all the while attempting to pull away from the two officers.

The handcuffs were applied and Bible was escorted to my vehicle. As Ofc. Malgrat and Ofc. Pettee passed the front end of my patrol vehicle, Bible put her right foot up on the front bumper and pushed back in an attempt to keep officers from moving her toward the back of the car.

She refused to remove her foot from the car and continued to push backward. Ofc. Pettee swept her right leg from the front of the car, which caused Bible to go down to the ground onto both knees. She was brought back up to her feet and was being escorted to the right rear of my car when she began to push against the officers. Bible's upper body was put over the front of my car in order to control her as Ofc. Pettee attempted to unlock the door. Bible at this point, picked up her left leg, kicked back and struck Ofc. M. Malgrat on his left knee and thigh. Ofc. Pettee took Bible's right arm and directed her to the ground. Bible sustained abrasions to her right face and both knees.

Sgt. J. Williamson and Key West Fire Department EMS (R5) were requested at the scene for evaluation and treatment of Bible. Monroe County Sheriffs Deputies A. Davis and K. Fricke arrived on scene to continue their investigation.

I searched Bible's purse, which contained numerous items with price tags. A dress, which was described to Dep. Davis by CVS employees, was located in the front seat of the car. The dress was turned over to Dep. Davis. The two cookies removed from Circle K by Bible (\$1.29 and .99, respectively), were turned back over to Circle K employees. Tiffany Lee, employee at Circle K, provided me with a security video showing Bible take the items and walk out of the store. It also partially shows Bible resisting officers at the front door (outside).

Bible was transported to the Monroe County Detention Center by Dep Davis. The items removed from Bibles purse were also turned over to Dep. Davis.

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On 2/12/2018 at approximately 1359 hours, I (Ofc M Malgrat) was dispatched to a suspicious vehicle/reckless driver in the area of Kennedy Drive and North Roosevelt Boulevard. KWPD dispatch advised that the caller stated the subject was driving erratically and "flipping" other driver off. KWPD dispatch was providing updates to the location of the driver. As the caller was calling in, MCSO dispatch called to advise that the vehicle and driver were involved in a theft in the Stock Island area. Ofc Keohane advised she observed the vehicle turn into the parking lot of 1890 N Roosevelt Blvd (Circle K). I arrived shortly after Ofc Keohane to the Circle K and I stood by as contact was made with the subject. The subject was inside the store and she was advised to exit the store and wait outside by the front door. As Ofc Pettee and I were standing with the subject, identified as Autum Bible, he asked her for identification. Bible stated it was in her car and began to walk toward the vehicle which was parked in front of the store. Ofc Pettee and I told Bible not to go to the vehicle and she ignored us and continued to walk toward the car. We once again told Bible to stop and no go toward the car and she ignored us again. Ofc Pettee and I then took ahold of Bible by her arms and attempted to stop her. Bible attempted to pull away from us and began to yell. Ofc Pettee and I pinned Bible against the building and attempted to handcuff her. Bible refused to put her hands behind her back and ignored our commands to do so. After struggling with Bible Ofc Pettee and I were able to secure her in handcuffs. Ofc Pettee and I attempted to escort Bible toward Ofc Keohane's patrol car. Bible put her foot out and stood on the front bumper. Ofc Pettee was able to sweep her leg off of the car. Bible went to the ground in the process and we were able to pick her back up. Bible continued to struggle with us as we walked her around to the passenger side of Ofc Keohane's car. Ofc Pettee and I pinned Bible against Ofc Keohane's car and attempted to get her into the car. Bible then kicked her left leg backwards several times striking me in the left knee and left inner thigh area. Ofc Pettee then took Bible to the ground as a result of her actions. Bible sustained minor abrasions to her face and legs as a result of going to the ground. KWFD Rescue was called to the scene to treat Bible's injuries. I completed a KWPD tow slip for the vehicle Bible was in possession of. I had no further involvement in this case.

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On Monday, 12 February 2018 at around 1400 hours, I (Officer M. Pettee) responded to 1890 North Roosevelt Blvd (Circle K) as a back up officer for Officer Keohane and Malgrat.

Officers were on scene looking for a female or male subject, later identified as Autum Bible. Bible was a suspect in a theft from Monroe County, as well as called in by multiple people as a reckless driver, stopping in the middle of intersections and flipping people off. Bibles vehicle was seen pulling into Circle K in a reckless manner.

I arrived on scene and entered the building. Bible was inside and had taken a cookie from Circle K. Bible then left the building without paying for the cookie. Bible was confronted outside. I told Bible to stand to the side of the door. I then asked Bible if she had an ID. Bible began walking toward her car. Officer Malgrat and I both told Bible not to go to her car. Bible refused to listen and continued toward her car. Officer Malgrat and I stopped Bible from going to her car. Bible began to physically attempt to push past us and began screaming and yelling. Officer Malgrat and I placed Bible against the building wall and attempted to put her in handcuffs. Bible continued to resist our attempts, but was eventually detained in handcuffs.

Officer Malgrat and I began to walk Bible toward Ofc. Keohanes car to place her in the rear seat. Bible continued resisting and placed her right foot against the front bumper of the police car. I was able to use my right leg to sweep her leg off the car and we continued bringing Bible to the car.

Once at the car, we placed Bible against the front right fender area to begin to open the door. Bible continued to physically resist, taking her left leg and kicking Ofc Malgrat several times. At this point I redirected Bible to the ground in order to overcome her kicking and have better control of her as she resisted. Bible was brought to the ground to her right side. Bible scraped her knee and her face on the ground, resulting in minor scrapes along her face and knee. Rescue was called to tend to Bible and a supervisor was called for a response to resistance incident.

MCSO arrived on scene and placed Bible under arrest for their case. MCSO transported Bible to the jail.

My body cam was turned on, then during the struggle off again. I turned it back on to record the incident, however nothing recorded when I attempted to download the video.
