Southbound on Whitehead Street. Panariello stated a friend was also riding alongside them on his scooter. Panariello stated there was a vehicle, described by him as a red Mitsubishi and having a FL. License plate Z16CST (photographed by Panariello) traveling in front of them in the same direction. Panariello stated the vehicle was a convertible and was occupied by two white males, later identified as Gregory Shields (suspect/driver) and Jeremy Sanger. Panariello stated he and his friends got into an argument with the Shields and Sanger before turning Eastbound onto Olivia Street. Panariello stated Shields then placed the vehicle in reverse and stopped the vehicle behind them on Olivia Street. Panariello stated Shields and Sanger then exited the vehicle and approached his friend still arguing. Panariello stated he then got off his bicycle and stood next to his friend. Panariello stated Shields then punched him on the left side of his face. I asked Panariello if he needed medical attention and he refused. Although Panariello refused medical attention he stated one of his molars felt rough and jagged. Panariello stated there was a witness outside of a residence on Olivia Street, later identified as Carmen Borrego, who stated she would speak to the police. I asked Panariello if he wished to pursue charges against the suspect should he be located and he said yes. I issued a BOLO over communications for the suspect's vehicle. I then took pictures of Panariello. I gave Panariello a Key West Police business card with a case number and my information and advised him if he sees the vehicle not to approach it and call the police immediately. I also advised him to send the pictures he took to my City of Key West email address.

I then left the scene to search the area for the vehicle and Officer N. Dantu went to meet with Borrego. Officer Dantu later stated he was unable to locate Borrego at the residence, but was advised she was at the Shell Station on North Roosevelt Boulevard and First Street. I then went to the Shell station and met with Borrego. Borrego stated she was sitting on her niece's porch when she saw two bicyclists and moped ride by laughing and joking. Borrego then stated she saw a vehicle make a right turn onto Olivia Street at the same time as the bicyclists and moped. Borrego stated the person on the moped was arguing with the people in the car and the car stopped. Borrego stated the argument escalated and two men got out of the vehicle. Borrego stated, "The driver of the car approached the gentleman who got off the bike and punched [him] in the face on the left side." Borrego stated she then told them she was calling the police and the vehicle sped off. Borrego gave me a sworn, written statement.

I then returned to 918 Duval Street and met with Panariello to get a better description of the suspect. While speaking to Panariello, I noticed his face was swollen and took additional pictures of Panariello. I then left and attempted to locate the vehicle once again in the lower Duval Street area.

While searching, communications advised there was complaint called in about a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle and having the same FL vehicle tag for driving erratically. Communications advised the vehicle was parked at the Sunbeam, 500 White Street. While on my way, Lieutenant J. Tripp called out he was conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle. On arrival I met with Lt. Tripp, who told me he witnessed Shields driving the vehicle and Shields told him he did not have a driver's license. Sanger was sitting in the passenger side of the vehicle. Lt. Tripp told me Shields said Sanger was the one driving to the Sunbeam. Lt. Tripp then gave me the ID's given to him by Shields and Sanger. Upon conducting a warrants check through communications, communications advised me Shields was possibly armed and dangerous. Sergeants Castillo, Rodriguez, and Officers Anglin and Dantu then arrived on scene. Sgt. Castillo then ordered Shields out of the vehicle. Sgt. Castillo then ordered Shields to walk backwards towards him with his hands on his head and then ordered Shields to get on the ground. Shields refused to comply and stated he was not going to the ground and continued walking backwards towards Sgt. Castillo, Sgt. Rodriguez, and Lt. Tripp. Sgt. Castillo, Sgt. Rodriguez, and Lt. Tripp then forcefully took Shields to the ground, handcuffed him, and placed him in the back of Sgt. Castillo's patrol car.

I then read Shields his Miranda Rights and asked him if he wished to speak to me. Shields acknowledged he understood his rights and stated he would speak to me. I asked Shields if he recalled the incident involving the two bicyclists and moped and he stated he did not. I then asked him who the vehicle he was driving, which does not belong to him, belongs to. He stated a coworker. I did not ask Shields any further questions.

Sanger was then released.

Upon completing my investigation, I found probable cause that Shields committed a Felony Battery by intentionally striking Panariello against his will and breaking his molar. I also found probable cause to charge Shields with Resisting Without Violence for refusing to comply with Sgt. Castillo's orders causing Sgt. Castillo, Sgt. Rodriguez, and Lt. Tripp to forcefully take him to the ground in order to handcuff him. I also found probable cause to charge Shields with Operating a Motor Vehicle Without a License due to Lt. Tripp witnessing him backing the vehicle out of the parking lot. I place Shields in the back of my patrol car and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center.

The witness statement provided to me by Borrego was submitted to the Key West Police Department Records Division. All the photos were uploaded to the Coban Server. The pill bottle was submitted by Ofc. Dantu to the Key West Police Department Property and Evidence Division for destruction.

BWC was activated and uploaded to the Coban Server.

On 2/25/18, at about 2212, I, Lieutenant J. Tripp, was on patrol in my marked unit. I heard a dispatched call of a reckless driver that had pulled into the market at 500 White Street. I was in the area and responded. When I arrived, I saw the maroon Mitsubishi convertible backing out of a parking space. The driver of the car was wearing the same grey hat as the driver described in the BOLO. I initiated a traffic stop. Communications indicated that the vehicle was also the suspect vehicle in a battery. I obtained identification from the driver and passenger. They both said they did not have drivers licenses. The driver told me that the passenger was the one that drove the car to the store. The driver was making quick movements as if to exit and as if reaching for something in his waistband.

Officer Torrecillas arrived and told me that they were suspects in a felony battery. He ran their names and an armed and dangerous safety warning was communicated to him. I requested more officers to the scene. Sergeant Castillo ordered the driver out of the car, to face away from us, and to walk back. When he was ordered to the ground, the driver verbally refused to do so and continued backing up, to the point that I had to do a kick to his calf and push him to the ground from behind. Sergeant Castillo and I handcuffed him and none of us were injured. He replied that he was sorry for being stupid.

Tripp stepped up, kicked Shields' calf, and forced him to the ground. Lt. Tripp and I handcuffed Shields without further incident. Once Shields was searched and secured in the rear of a patrol car, the passenger (Jeremy Sanger) was ordered out of the car and taken into custody without incident.

On 25FEB18 at 2217, I (Ofc. T. ANGLIN) responded to the Sunbeam Market, located at 500 White Street regarding a request from Ofc. J. TORRECILLAS for additional Officer respond to his scene. Upon my arrival, I was instructed by Lt. J. TRIPP to position my vehicle to assist Officers in effecting a risk traffic stop. I observed two white males, later identified as GREGORY T SHIELDS and SANGER J ALLEN sitting in a maroon 2001 Mitsubishi Spyder, (FL Tag# Z16CST) in the parking lot with Ofc. J. TORRECILLAS, Lt. J. TRIPP and Sgt. J. CASTILLO having their vehicles positioned directly behind them. I spoke with Lt. J. TRIPP, who informed me that the two subjects were involved in a felony battery incident and computer checks revealed that the subjects had a violent history and were considered armed and dangerous.

I cleared the immediate area of innocent bystanders and coordinated additional responding Officers. Moments later, Ofc. J. TORRECILLAS, Lt. J. TRIPP, Sgt. J. CASTILLO and Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ commenced with the high-risk traffic stop and began giving verbal commands for the driver, SHIELDS, to step out of the vehicle. I maintained an over watch position at my vehicle and Ofc. N. DANTU and I covered the passenger, ALLEN, who was still seated in the vehicle. While I was giving verbal commands for ALLEN to keep his hands visible, I observed SHIELDS becoming non-complainant by not laying on the ground, (As per Officers commands). While Officers attempted to assist SHIELDS to the ground and handcuff him, he continued to resist by maintaining a rigid stance and tensing. After observing SHIELDS' resistance, I elected to retrieve K-9 BEN to assist with the high risk stop.

I informed Ofc. N. DANTU of my intentions and affixed a six-foot nylon lead to the nylon harness K-9 BEN was wearing. I retrieved K-9 BEN from the rear of my patrol vehicle and maintained an over-watch position. After SHIELDS was taken into custody and secured in the rear of Sgt. J. CASTILLO'S patrol vehicle, Officers began giving commands for ALLEN to step out of the vehicle while I maintained my over watch position with K-9 BEN. After ALLEN was taken into custody without incident and secured in Ofc. J. TORRECILLAS' patrol vehicle, I secured K-9 BEN in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

I assisted Ofc. J. TORRECILLAS by standing by his vehicle, (Watching over ALLEN) as he conducted his investigation. I later assisted in conducting an inventory search of the Mitsubishi prior to it being towed from the scene.

I did not interview any parties associated with this incident. The incident was captured on my VieVu body worn camera and later uploaded into the Coban server.
