A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE MARCH 24, 2018 "MARCH FOR OUR LIVES - KEY WEST"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the March for Our Lives on Duval for Children's Rights in Key West, on March 24, 2018, and in conjunction with the March for Our Lives March on Washington, and similar marches around the United States, intends to send a message that our lives and safety become a priority and that we end gun violence and mass shootings in our schools today; and

WHEREAS, the March supports advocacy for safe schools, and calls on defenders of students across the city who will no longer risk their lives waiting for someone else to take action to stop the epidemic of mass school shootings that has become all too familiar to join the march along Duval to unify communities in Key West and Monroe County to create change from the grassroots level up; and

WHEREAS, the March specifically declares itself nonpartisan and inclusive of all those who defend school safety and reflects the unique character of the Florida Keys with an emphasis on Key West's One Human Family commitment. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission urges residents to support the March for Our Lives on Duval as a means of reinforcing the message that all children deserve to feel safe in schools.

Section 2: That the City Commission urges residents to support individuals and organizations that work to unify the communities of the Florida Keys and Key west.

Section 3: That the City Commission urges residents to put aside partisan politics for this March as a statement to our communities, the State, the Nation and the new administration that the defense of children's lives is important and that this march reflects the unique cultures of our communities.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
