The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Key West; and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Key West; and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to his signature and affix the Seal of the City thereto.

Section 2. That all neighboring property owners and/or tenants shall be notified of the

events approved in the attached agreement.
