WHEREAS, Hurricane Irma made landfall in the Lower Keys on September 10, 2017, causing significant damage and necessitating a large volume of inspections and designs for repair of City infrastructure; and WHEREAS, City staff recommends execution of the attached Addendums, for each of the named contractors, to implement certain required clauses for the City to request reimbursement from FEMA for damage caused by Hurricane Irma; and
