On 6/8/18 at approximately 1430 hours I (Ofc Standerwick) was at the mid 500 block of Duval Street speaking with a local vagrant. While speaking with him an employee of CVS, later identified as James Jackson (CVS employee), was pursuing and yelling at a white male who was carrying a beer, later identified as Trey Johnson (Defendant). I asked Mr. Jackson what was wrong, and he informed me the Defendant had stolen a beer from the CVS.

I caught up to the Defendant at 520 Duval Street where I attempted to stop him. I grabbed him by the shoulder and he looked at me and immediately attempted to pull away. I was wearing my clearly marked Key West Police Bike Uniform at the time of this incident. I was able to get the Defendant to the ground and I gave him verbal commands to get on the ground; however, he was able to get back to his feet. The Defendant continued to resist me by pulling away and attempting to flee. The Defendant faced me and I pushed him into a pillar at the San Carlos institute. I again ordered the Defendant to the ground and he refused my commands. I attempted to turn the Defendant to place his hands behind his back, and he kept turning away from me in an attempt to flee. During the struggle the Defendant asked, "What the issue is Sir?" I informed it was because he stole a beer. I gave him loud verbal commands to get on the ground which he refused. The Defendant called me "Officer" and continued to pull away from me. I wrestled with the Defendant and put his body against the pillars of the San Carlos institute. I kept giving him verbal commands to get on the ground, but he kept resisting me by refusing to put his arms behind his back and to follow my lawful commands. At one point during me giving him commands to get on the ground the Defendant said, "ok ok alright". I assumed the Defendant was going to follow my lawful command, but he didn't and he again tried to pull away from me. At this point The Defendant almost broke free from me when he turned and pulled away. At this point we were located right by the doors of the San Carlos Institute. I was able to grab the Defendant by his arm and push him into the wall and I informed him, "I was going to tase him if he didn't' cut the shit". The Defendant then stood in front of me and put his hands on his head. I informed Ofc Betz to, "Step it up". At this point I did not realize I was still on channel 2. I walked the Defendant over to the mailbox area of the wall of the San Carlos and told the Defendant to get on his knees which he did. I repeatedly had to tell the Defendant to put his hands behind his back. I used my left hand on the Defendant's neck to control the Defendant and to feel if he was going to buck up against me. The Defendant said, "Sir I am listening to you, but I am wondering". The Defendant was stalling me and was not complying with my lawful order, and I informed him again that I was going to tase him. Then the Defendant placed his arms behind his back and I handcuffed him. I then stood up to use my radio to call for assistance. I turned to Duval street to see if any patrol cars were there so I could flag them down to my location.

At that point the Defendant rolled to his side and used the wall to stand up. The Defendant got to his feet and fled South on Duval Street. I chased the Defendant to to the intersection of Duval and Applerouth, when the Defendant turned onto Applerouth Lane.' During the turn on Applerouth the Defendant's footing slipped and he began to stumble. At this point I deployed my taser from approximately 12 feet striking the Defendant in the back. The probes stuck the Defendant in the back with an approximate spread of ten inches and once he gave me compliance, I turned off the taser. The taser gave the Defendant a 4 second cycle. After the cycle I put my knee on the Defendant and held him on the ground until Ofc. Medina arrived.

Ofc Medina removed the probes from the Defendant's back and took photos of the Defendant. Medina also took photos of my injuries which included; scraped knees and elbows. KWFD Rescue 5 responded and they checked out and the Defendant. The Defendant did not suffer any injuries except for the penetration by the Taser Probes. Key West Rescue 5 administered first aid for the Taser strike and cleared the Defendant.

Ofc. Betz transported the Defendant to my patrol vehicle at 800 Emma where he was transferred to my KWPD Ford Explorer. On the way to the jail I read the Defendant his Miranda Rights and he agreed to speak with me. The Defendant admitted to the theft and informed me he was sorry for resisting me and that he really is not a bad guy. At the jail the Defendant was given a pen and paper and he wrote me a note saying how sorry he was for stealing the beer from Mr. Jackson at CVS and for resisting me. The Defendant was turned over to MCSO corrections and processed into the jail without incident.

Since the Defendant did remove a beer from CVS, 527 Duval St, and failed to pay for the merchandise, the Defendant was charged in violation of FSS 812.014(3)(a).

Since the Defendant did resist my lawful commands to stop and attempted to pull away from me as I, a law

On Friday, June 08th, 2018, at approximately 1345 hours, I (Officer G. Medina) responded to the intersection of applerouth and Duval Street in reference to backup for Officer S. Standerwick. Officer S. Standerwick advised that a TASER deployment was done.

Upon my arrival, I parked my patrol vehicle on Applerouth and Duval and observed Officer Standerwick holding his TASER over a white individual (later identified as Trey Wesley Johnson) with the wires of the device hanging. Johnson was laying on his belly facing the ground in handcuffs. I turned him over, so that I could remove the prongs from his back. He had one probe on the upper portion of his backside, while the second probe was closer to the lower portion of his backside.

The cartridge was placed into Key West Property as evidence.

Photographs were later done and submitted into the COBAN server as evidence as well.

Photographs were also taken of Officer S. Standerwick who suffered minor injuries to his elbow and knee area.

See Body worn camera for statements issued by the subject spontaneously saying that it was wrong for him to do what he did.

I was informed by Officer S. Standerwick that Johnson had stolen a beer from a store and ran off. Apparently Officer S. Standerwick was notified of the theft and apprehended him. While detained in handcuffs Johnson had fled.

Officer Betz and Officer V. Arguello arrived on scene and placed Johnson inside their patrol vehicle.

Officer Standerwick advised that business employees at 518 Duval Street had possibly witnessed the event. I went to the location and spoke with staff. Some of the staff informed me that they had seen the subject being detained by Officer Standerwick on the side of their business. While being detained they witnessed the subject run off and being chased by Officer Standerwick. I spoke with one staff member who had access to their surveillance cameras and showed me the event.

I observed Johnson being detained by Officer Standerwick initially in view of the cameras then out of view around the corner. Shortly afterwards you witness Johnson running around the corner being chased by Officer Standerwick. They did not have cameras that had shown the deployment of the TASER.

I had one staff member write a sworn written statement, which I later submitted into Records.

After struggling with him for an extended period and then running to catch up to him, I realized I was at a disadvantage with him physically. I was exhausted from wrestling with the Defendant and I knew the Defendant was going to be physically resistant to me again if I could catch him. I was also worried the people in the street would be put at risk if he continued to flee by possibly running into the many pedestrians occupying the sidewalk. I also feared the Defendant may run into traffic and get hit by a passing car causing him great bodily harm. It was with these factors in mind I used my taser to stop the Defendant from fleeing me.
