A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting on August 15, 2018, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended approval of this Task Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order under the City's General Utilities Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$287,910.46, for Seaport Parking Lot Rehabilitation is hereby approved.

Section 2: That \$170,199.00 is budgeted (FY 17/18) in KWB Infrastructure Fund Account 405-7505-575-6300 (Project KB75051701 - Seaport Parking Lot Rehabilitation). A budget transfer in the amount of \$117,712.00 is hereby authorized from the reserve fund. (Funding request for FY18/19 will be cancelled upon approval of this project.)

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon the consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
