On Monday, August 27, 2018, at approximately 0107 hours, Officer Leahy and I, Officer J. Young, responded to 724 Duval St. (Bourbon St. Pub) in reference to a trespasser who had made attempts to punch the bar security as he was escorted off of the property.

Key West COMM1 told me the trespasser was described as a short, white male, with a blonde beard, wearing a black tank top and tan shorts.

I arrived on scene and parked my patrol vehicle on Petronia St., before reaching Duval St.

I observed a large crowd gathered outside of the bar and I was approached by two white males, identified as Milan Culum and Ryan Mcauley. I briefly spoke with Culum and Mcauley in the intersection and was told the male suspect described above had punched and kicked them inside of the bar. While Culum and Mcauley were telling me their chain of events I saw a Mccrea exit 801 Pub at the southern exit. Mcauley yelled at Mccrea to stop and come back. Mccrea stopped and walked towards me.

I instructed Mccrea to sit down on the curb and he did not comply. Mccrea began heckling me by pulling out his cellular telephone and activating the recording feature. Mccrea yelled at me, asking if he was under arrest, stating he knew his rights. I explained to Mccrea he was the subject of an investigation in a crime which occurred within the Bourbon St. Pub.

Officer Leahy arrived on scene as a back up unit.

Mccrea continued yelling at us and would not comply with any verbal commands given by Officer Leahy. Officer Leahy drew his TASER and pointed it at Mccrea and gave him loud, verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Mccrea did not do anything and appeared to be in disbelief a TASER was being pointed at him. I placed Mccrea's hands behind his back and handcuffed him.

Mccrea began tensing his body, pulling away from us, yelling and screaming obscenities.

Mccrea acted out of control to the point Officer Leahy and I had to restrain him against the front of my patrol car. Mccrea started kicking backwards attempting to kick Officer Leahy and I in the area of our knees and lower legs. Mccrea slammed his head against the hood of my car, causing three dents on my hood. I estimated the damage to my car to be at approximately \$500.00 dollars to repair the damage. Mccrea was kicking more violently and Officer Leahy took his pepper spray from his belt and deployed a few second spray from the can onto Mccrea's face.

Mccrea continued to become more violent and attempted to escape our grasp. Mccrea tried to run southbound on Duval St. and Officer Leahy and I took Mccrea to the ground. I restrained Mccrea on the ground while Officer Leahy retrieved his Hobbles from his patrol car to secure Mccrea.

Several other back up units arrived on scene to assist.

Every attempt was made to remove the residual pepper spray from Mccrea's face. Mccrea continued to act irrational and was uncooperative.

Mccrea was placed into the rear of my patrol car and Key West Fire / Rescue was requested to respond to the scene.

Mccrea continued to act violent in the back seat of my patrol car by attempting to kick the interior but Mccrea was unsuccessful due to the confinement of the half cage prisoner area. Mccrea was banging his head against the partition.

Sgt. Rodriguez and I decided to meet with Key West Fire / Rescue at the police station instead of on scene due to Mccrea's violent and disruptive behavior, a large crowd was forming near us to watch, disrupting their patronage from each establishment.

I transported Mccrea to the rear parking lot of the Key West Police Department where I met with Key West Fire / Rescue. Key West Fire / Rescue did not wish to provide any treatment to Mccrea for a pepper spray exposure. Mccrea was brought to the rear of the police station where Sgt. Rodriguez, Officer Tyler and Officer Calvert took Mccrea out of my patrol car. We washed the remainder of the pepper spray off of Mccrea's face and flushed his eyes with water.

After Mccrea had been cleaned up he continued to resist by refusing to walk to my car. Mccrea was carried to my car and placed back into the rear seat. Mccrea made every attempt to passively resist and was telling us that he was not going to walk, follow any of our instructions and resist all of our efforts to put him into my car.

I transported Mccrea to the Monroe County Detention Center. Mccrea screamed obscenities towards me the entire transport. Mccrea also begged to be let go and he would never speak of what bad things we had done to him. Mccrea made statements to me that he was going to seek some type of revenge against me and the other officers on scene. Mccrea stated several times over he was a combat veteran, an ARMY Ranger with high ranking friends and that I should watch out when he gets released from jail.

At the Jail, Officer Tyler took Mccrea out of my patrol car and brought Mccrea to the intake area.

Officer Haynie met me in the Sally Port and provided me witness statements from the victims from Bourbon St. Pub.

Once I reached the intake area of the Monroe County Detention Center, Mccrea had already been strapped into the restraint chair. Mccrea yelled at Deputy Sgt. Katz, Deputy Valencia, Officer Tyler, Officer Grassi and myself, "I will kill all of you. I will kill all you cops". Mccrea continued to state how much of a mistake we all hade made and I (Officer Young) had better watch out when he is released from jail. Mccrea made several statements that he was intending of inflicting physical harm on me by punching in the face because, "You are nothing but a pussy ass, KWPD cop".

As the Monroe County Detention Deputies tended to Mccrea, I sat down in the report writing area to read the Witness Statements. I read Mccrea was inside of Bourbon St. Pub, consuming alcoholic beverages at the bar, sitting next to Macauley calling him and the other patrons of the bar "Faggots" and that they were "Burning in hell". Macauley relayed Mccrea's verbal statements to the bartender, who told this to Culum, bar security.

Culum approached Mccrea and escorted him out of the bar and to the sidewalk. Mccrea left the bar, later to return minutes later. Macauley was leaving the bar at the time Mccrea returned. Mccrea punched Culum twice in the stomach with a closed fist. Macauley was attempting to leave the bar when Mccrea yelled at him, calling Macauley "A fucking faggot" and kicked him. Mccrea also kicked Culum as well.

Mccrea left the altercation to enter The 801 Pub, where he was later seen by me leaving upon my arrival.

Mccrea continued his disruptive behavior in the restraint chair by banging his head on the chair, kicking his feet on the footboards of the restraint chair and forcing the chair backwards. At one point, Mccrea kicked the restraint chair backwards as Sgt. Katz was standing behind it, striking Sgt. Katz in the stomach.

The jail nurse refused Mccrea as an inmate due to her not being able to get his vital signs. The jail nurse told me she was requiring medical clearance from Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room before she would accept Mccrea as an inmate.

Key West Fire / Rescue responded to the jail to transport Mccrea to the hospital.

Sgt. Katz, Deputy Valencia and I rolled Mccrea into the elevator in the restraint chair into the elevator. Mccrea made several attempts to kick Sgt. Katz and Deputy Valencia. Mccrea was able to strike Deputy Valencia and Sgt. Katz once or twice on the side of their bodies with his foot. Mccrea's kicks to Deputy Valencia and Sgt. Katz were deliberate and Mccrea intended to kick them. Mccrea made the statement, "I am going to kill all the cops".

I retrieved the Hobbles from my patrol car and secured Mccrea's legs.

Mccrea was transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center by ambulance. I rode with Key West Fire / Rescue during the transport to the Emergency Room. Officer Tyler followed behind the ambulance.

Officer Torrecillas met us at the Emergency Room to assist with Mccrea, due to his continuous violent behavior.

At the Emergency Room Mccrea continued yelling as loud as he could, disrupting the peace and quiet of the other patients of the Emergency Room requiring medical treatment. Mccrea was given a sedative for his violent behavior by the Emergency Room Doctor. Once it was established Mccrea was not in need of any medical attention he was discharged from the Emergency Room with medical clearance.

Officer Torrecillas transported Mccrea back to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Mccrea was still non-compliant and the restraint chair was brought into the Sally Port, where he was again secured.

With the sedatives working the jail nurse was able to get Mccrea's vital signs and accepted as an inmate.

I do not have any body camera footage available due to it being uploaded at the time I was dispatched to this call for service.

On 08/27/2018, at approximately 0104 hours, Officer Young and I, Officer Leahy responded to 724 Duval Street (Bourbon) about a battery/trespasser.

Upon arrival, I observed Officer Young standing at Duval and Petronia Street with a white male, later identified by name and date of birth as Shane McCrea (Arrestee). I exited my patrol vehicle and approached Officer Young and McCrea. I observed McCrea to be belligerent and unsteady on his feet. While speaking with McCrea, I observed his speech to be very slurred. I suspected McCrea was under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and highly intoxicated. Due to McCrea's aggressive actions, I felt McCrea needed to be handcuffed and detained pending further investigation, I displayed my TASER and I gave McCrea lawful verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. At first, McCrea did not place his hands behind his back, but then after being warned several times about being tased, McCrea complied and placed his hands behind his back. Officer Young handcuffed McCrea. After being handcuffed, McCrea attempted to pull away from Officer Young and became very combative. Officer Young moved McCrea to the hood of his patrol vehicle to gain control of McCrea. I took hold of McCrea's left arm and placed my right hand on McCrea's head to hold him down and try to control him. McCrea kept thwarting our efforts to take control of him and became more combative. McCrea continued to try and pull away from us, turning his body and shoulders. I removed my less-lethal cannister of OC spray from my duty belt and aimed it towards the forehead area of McCrea. I sprayed the OC spray to the forehead, face area of McCrea. During the release of the OC spray, both Officer Young and my vision were affected by the OC spray. We were able to bring McCrea down to the ground in a controlled manner and hold him down. I placed a hobble around McCrea's ankles to prevent him from kicking us. KWPD officers arrived on scene and assisted with the arrest.

The incident was captured on my incar front camera and microphone.

I, Officer J. Torrecillas, was at the Emergency Room, Lower Keys Medical Center, reference a separate incident. Upon clearing from my incident, I heard over communications Officer B. Tyler and Officer J. Young were on their way with McCrea, who was being combative. I waited for their arrival to assist.

Key West Fire Rescue then arrived with McCrea and Ofc. Young, while Ofc. Tyler was following in his patrol car. McCrea was brought into the Emergency Room by KWFR personnel and refused to comply with the ER staff. The ER Dr. also attempted to speak to McCrea, but McCrea continued to yell and be uncooperative. The ER staff was able medically clear McCrea, and we placed McCrea in the back of my patrol car and I transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Upon arrival, MCSO Deputies met Ofc. Young, Ofc. Tyler, and I in the sally port and placed McCrea in a restraint chair.

My BWC was activated and uploaded to Axon Evidence.

On August 27, 2018 at 0107 Officer Young was dispatched to 724 Duval Street in reference to a battery. Officer Young arrested Shane McCrea for battery on scene, McCrea was combative on scene and was peppered sprayed during the incident.

Officer Young called for EMS on scene to have McCrea evaluated, EMS was taking a while to respond so Officer Young transported McCrea to the police station to have EMS evaluate him behind the station. On the radio you could hear McCrea yelling and screaming so I (Ofc. Tyler) responded to the Police Station to assist Officer Young with McCrea.

Upon arrival at the police station I met with Officer Young and EMS personnel behind the station, EMS said he did not know what we wanted him to do for him. Sgt. Rodriquez decided to have myself and Ofc. Young take him to the water hose behind the station to hose him off. I took McCrea out of Officer Youngs vehicle, he was screaming and yelling and crying, he had snot coming from his nose and his eyes were closed. McCrea was very uncooperative while trying to get him out of the vehicle. I got him onto the curb and Sgt. Rodriquez put water on his face. McCrea said he felt better, he then started yelling and screaming saying he is a vet and started cursing at the officers outside.

McCrea was going from being cooperative and polite to argumentative. We asked McCrea if he was okay to get back into the vehicle, he said he was. Myself, Sgt. Rodriquez, Ofc. Calvert were trying to get McCrea back into the vehicle, but he stated he was not helping us. McCrea started using passive aggression against us. McCrea started flailing around numerous times, we finally got him into Officer Young's vehicle. Officer Young transported McCrea to the Monroe County Detention Center, I followed Officer Young to assist him at the Detention Center.

At the Detention Center McCrea continued to be combative towards officers, he continued to cuss at officers and refused to follow any directions. Upstairs in the Detention Center McCrea was placed in the restraint chair, he continued to yell and scream cussing the officers and telling us he is a vet, and we are holding him against his will. McCrea slammed his body around numerous times in the chair at one point stated when he gets out of the chair he is going to kill every officer in this room.

McCrea was slamming his body around in the chair so violently he moved the chair back and it struck Sgt. Katz from Monroe County Sheriff's Office in the stomach. Officer Young had to end up calling EMS to the Detention Center because McCrea was refused by medical staff at the jail, and he needed to be transported to the hospital. McCrea got very combative in the elevator to the sally port with Sgt. Katz. McCrea was still combative with officers while trying to get him onto the gurney to be placed in the ambulance. His legs had to be hobbled and he had to be strapped down to the gurney.

At the hospital McCrea continued to be loud and was cursing very loudly, the hospital staff advised us the other patients in the ER were getting scared from the way he was acting. The hospital staff gave McCrea a shot that calmed
