A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "REVOCABLE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY" ("MOU") BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHEREIC ADMINISTRATION (NOAA) NATIONAL OCEAN SERVICE (NOS) FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A TIDAL STATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, relocation of a tide station from the East Quay is necessary, due to development of the Truman Waterfront at the former location; and

WHEREAS, relocation will provide continuity with historical, and future tidal data, providing vital information applicable to Key West Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that allowing NOAA to relocate, install and maintain a tidal station within the easement granted to the City by the US Navy, would provide a benefit to residents of Key West and the United States.
