A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A PURCHASING EXCEPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO ALLOW A CHANGE ORDER TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES GROUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,833.45 FOR MAILINGS OF STORMWATER ASSESSMENT PROGRAM NOTICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 2-796 of the Code of Ordinances requires competitive bidding for purchases or services in excess of \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, to adjust proposed future adjustments to the stormwater assessment program, it is necessary this year to notice all property owners in order to comply with state statutes; and

WHEREAS, Government Services Group is the sole-source consultant which assists the City in preparation and mailing of stormwater assessment rolls for the Tax Collector, and compliance with State statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager finds that pursuant to section 2-797(1) and 2-797(4), it is in the best interest of the City to authorize an expenditure in excess of \$20,000.00 for services provided by sole source vendor, Government Services Group, this fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a purchasing exception, to allow a change order in the amount of \$13,833.45 for sole source vendor Government Services Group, is hereby approved accordance with Key West City Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) and 2-797(4)(b).

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
