Section 1: That the attached Task Order for FY19, under the Marketing Services Contract is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$193,000.00.

Section 2: That adequate funding is anticipated in the FY 18/19 budget as follows: Key West Historic Seaport \$167,400 in account No. 405-7504-575-4800 and Key West Bight Marina \$35,000 in account No. 405-7503-575-4800.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
