

Purpose of Presentation

 Appearing before this committee to object to a request to give public property to an individual who has already encroached upon and blocked the public alley.



Sec. 62-2. - Obstructions.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person willfully to obstruct the free, convenient and ordinary use of any public right-of-way, street, roadway, alley, sidewalk, swale or public square by impeding, hindering, stifling, retarding or restraining the passage of either pedestrian or vehicular traffic or by endangering the safe movement of pedestrians or vehicles travelling thereon.
- (b) This section shall not apply to the right of assembly or to any other purpose for which a government has issued a permit; provided, however, that a permit to use a public area for a commercial purpose does not authorize obstruction.
- (c) Violations shall be punishable as provided in section 1-15.


Dear Commissioner Lopez:

For over twenty years I have been trying to get the City of Key West to open the alley/lane in the 200 block of Olivia Street that leads to my property. I have talked with many City officials, past and present, who acknowledged that the alley/lane is Public Property but nothing has been done to open it up. I have obtained maps from 1912 to the present that clearly shows the alley/lane on them. In addition to the maps, I have an official survey of my property that shows the alley/lane with its boundaries and dimensions.

Many of the officials with whom I have discussed this matter with are no longer employed by the City. Now, I find myself having to explain the problem over and over again to new City officials. I am not pleased with the manner inwhich the City has treated me for requesting that the Public's Right of Way be opened. It appears to me that the effective and timely resolution of this problem and the enforcement of code violations involving the blocking or taking of the City's property is not a concern of your staff.











1912 Sandborn Map
