An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Royal Poinciana tree**. A site inspection was done and documented the following:

Tree Species: Royal Poinciana (Delonix regia)

Diameter: 40.7" (one base with three main trunks)

Location: 40% (growing in between two structures, possible root issues with structures-utilities, foundation)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 50% (fair, large tree with heavy canopy, decay in old cuts along main branches, some evidence of termite mud in crotch with main trunks, canopy has some storm damage and dead branches)

Total Average Value = 63%

Value x Diameter = 25.6 replacement caliper inches

Additional information (documentation) requested from homeowners of two structures regarding utility issues, termites, and health of canopy.

To the City of Key West Tree Commission

We have a house at 615 Grinnell Street. We have owned our house since August 31, 1998. There is a large Poinciana tree on the adjacent property at 611 Grinnell. In 2011 we found that we had subterranean termites and had to treat the ground around our house. We tented our house for drywood termites in 2010. In 2016 we discovered the termites had returned and we had to tent again. The Poinciana tree appears to be the source for the termites. Termites are a problem for a wood house such as we have. When the termites swarm in our living room, we are unhappy.

We concur with the opinion of our neighbors that this tree has reached the end of its useful, healthy life and it is time for it to be removed.

Dear Karen DeMaria,

Based on our meeting last Wednesday and in addition to Tom Stroh's arguments for the tree removal,
here our reasons:

My wife and I have lived at 611 Grinnell St #1 since 2002. Shortly after buying the house it had substantial work done: replacing floor framing, sub floor and installing new hardwood floor. In 2016 we discovered major damage in the hardwood floor, Subterranean termites were eating through our house floors. The colony originated from the Royal Poinciana tree behind our house (611 Grinnell St #2, Tom Stroh). It became necessary to treat the whole house as well as the tree (copies have been provided). We also had to trim the tree of mostly decayed branches. Within the last 6 months, we experienced branches breaking off the trunk, and all of them have been infested with living, active subterranean termites. We have two small children, 8 and 10 years old, and I am very concerned about the risk of a branch falling, or the tree entirely, on our children or our home. The rotted tree puts our family's home at further risk during high winds that may topple the tree in any direction during a tropical storm or hurricane. Let alone the fact that termites will continue to eat our home. Today I met with Truly Nolan, Termite Pest Control. They inspected the tree and confirmed living subterranean termites, again. His name is Cody McCain, email: cody.mccain@trulymail.net, phone: 305 394 0314, and he is happy to clarify his result. Here his email he send to me:

Today at 10:20 A.M. I observed live subterranean termites in the the poinciana tree at the back right corner of the home located at 611 Grinnell St. unit 1 the tree is located on unit 2's property. If you have any questions please let me know. Thank you and have a great day today.
