Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate a contract with the first-ranked firm, William P. Horn Architect, PA, and if the City is unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract, negotiations with that firm will be formally terminated and negotiations undertaken with the second-ranked firm, until an acceptable agreement for Tasks 1 and 2 described in the RFQ is reached.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract for Tasks 1 and 2 described in the RFQ, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this project will be funded via
transfer from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to the Colleg
Road Affordable Workforce Housing Project (CP19001802).
