A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A WOMENS MARCH ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 19, 2019, STARTING AT 1:00 P.M. AT THE SOUTHERNMOST CAFÉ AND ENDING AT MALLORY SQUARE; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS FOR THE MARCH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
