A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING ATTACHED "STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. LP44032" BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF **ENVIRONMENTAL** PROTECTION AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA KEYS STEWARDSHIP ACT FUNDING UPGRADE OF EXISTING WASTEWATER LIFT STATIONS (FY17-18 GAA LINE ITEM 1593A) IN AN UP TO MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$937,667.00; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this grant will support construction of the City of Key West Sewer Lift Station Rehab Phase 1 and Phase 2 project, using funds provided through the Florida Keys Environmental Stewardship Act; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Standard Grant Agreement No. LP44032," between the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and the City of Key West (FY17-18 GAA LINE ITEM 1593A) for upgrade of existing wastewater lift stations is hereby approved in an up to maximum amount of \$937,667.00.

Section 2: That grant funds are budgeted in Revenue Account 401-0000-334-3900/SE1504 (Sewer Fund Other Physical Environment), and grant eligible construction costs are budgeted in Expense Account 401-3503-535-6500/SE1504 (Sewer Fund

Construction in Progress), and any necessary budget transfers are
authorized. No matching funds are required.
Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute
the necessary documents to enact this Agreement, upon advice and
consent of the City Attorney.
Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by
the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
