An application was received requesting the removal of (1) Horseflesh Mahogany, (1) Autograph tree, (1) Mango, and (1) African Tulip tree. A site inspection was done and documented the following:




Tree Species: Horseflesh Mahogany (Lysiloma sabicu)




Autograph Tree














Diameter: 9.5"

Location: 70% (growing under canopy of Royal Poinciana tree)

Species: 50% (not on protected tree list)


Condition: 60% (fair, co-dominant trunks, lopsided canopy primarily due to

growing under Royal Poinciana tree and storm damage)


Total Average Value = 60%

Value x Diameter = 5.7 replacement caliper inches










Diameter: 1.9" Location: 70%

Condition: 40% (poor, poor structure, roots uplifted)



Condition: 40% (poor, poor structure, lopsided canopy)



Value x Diameter = 2.3" replacement caliper inches


Tree Species: African Tulip (Spathodea campanulata) 01/25/2019



















Diameter: 23.5" (multi trunked)

Location: 50% (canopy close to utility lines, one trunk sitting on structure)

Species: 50% (not on protected tree list)

Condition: 50% (fair to poor, poor structure-sprawling tree, evidence of

health issues in trunks, some decay in the main trunk and canopy)

Total Average Value = 50%

Value x Diameter = 11.7 replacement caliper inches

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the removal of one (1) Horseflesh Mahogany, (1) Autograph tree, (1) Mango, and (1) African Tulip tree at 322 Elizabeth Street to be replaced with a total of 21 caliper inches of trees from approved list, FL#1, to be planted on site.
