On January 3, 2019, at approximately 1800 hours, the Key West Police Department Special Investigations Unit executed a search warrant at 301 White Street, Apartment 12C, Key West, Florida. The Honorable Judge Mark Jones signed the warrant authorizing the search of 301 White Street, Apartment 12C. I (Detective Henry del Valle) served as the case agent.

The Key West Police Department's Special Response Team entered the apartment. While in the apartment, SRT member detained Gary Daub, who is the registered occupant, and Michael Hennigan Jr. Hennigan was visiting Daub at the apartment.

Detective Jay Conaty video recorded me as I read the search warrant aloud in Daub and Hennigan's presence. Both acknowledged hearing me clearly. I then read both Daub and Hennigan their Constitutional rights (Miranda) individually and documented doing so on my body-worn camera (BWC). Both Daub and Hennigan acknowledged understanding their rights. Both Daub and Hennigan individually agreed to speak with me. I asked Daub if anyone else lived in his apartment. Daub told me that Jamie also lived in his apartment until she could get ger own apartment; however, Daub didn't say she payed rent.

Detective Jay Conaty, Detective Karl Malsheimer, and Drug Enforcement Administration Special Agent (SA) David Parkhurst searched Daub's living room and kitchen. Detective Sergeant Bradley Lariz and I searched Daub's bedroom, bathroom, and bedroom closet. Detective Malsheimer photographed the recovered items and Detective Jesse Hammers served as the property custodian. Monroe County Special Operations Unit Detectives Tyler Blanton and Matthew Cory assisted with scene security.

While searching Daub's living room couch, Detective Conaty found several pair of shoes that contained assorted drug paraphernalia. Some of the paraphernalia field-tested positive (FTP) for cocaine. I asked Daub about the shoes and the paraphernalia. Daub told me the shoes and contents were his.

While speaking with Hennigan, I asked him about a syringe SRT members recovered from his pocket. During our conversation, Hennigan told me the syringe may contain Molly.

While searching Daub's bedroom, Detective Sergeant Lariz and I found personal items, clothing, and correspondence suggesting a female, who was not present, also occupied the dwelling. Based on the correspondence, we identified Jamie as Jemal "Jamie" Myatiyeva. Detective Sergeant Lariz found a digital scale in a bedroom night table. The scale contained FTP cocaine. While searching the bathroom trash receptacle, I found a small zipper-type plastic bag that contained a trace amount of FTP cocaine.

Detectives recovered the following items from Daub's apartment:

- 1. Brillo pad, push rod, metal pipe & plastic baggie, w/FTP cocaine residue, found inside Daub's right blue and orange Puma shoe (Detective Conaty)
- 2. Brillo pad & plastic baggies, w/FTP cocaine residue, found in Daub's left blue and orange Puma shoe (Detective Conaty)
- 3. Six plastic baggies, w/FTP cocaine residue, & one glass smoking pipe, found in Daub's black & white Puma shoes (Detective Conaty)
- 4. Syringe w/needle found in Hennigan's right shorts cargo pocket (SRT Officer T. Anglin)
- 5. Glass pipe found in Daub's blue Under Armor shoe (Detective Conaty)
- 6. Clear plastic baggie, w/FTP cocaine residue, found in the bathroom receptacle (Detective H. del Valle)

- 7. .3 grams FTP marijuana found under Daub's couch (Detective Conaty)
- 8. Four plastic baggies, w/FTP cocaine residue, found under Daub's sofa (Detective Conaty)
- 9. Small glass smoking pipe found under Daub's sofa chair (Detective Conaty)
- 10. Silver digital scale, w/FTP cocaine residue, found in Jemal "Jamie" Myatiyeve's bed room (Sgt. Lariz)
- 11. Metal spoon, w/FTP MDMA, located in kitchen cabinet above sink (Detective Conaty)
- 12. Plastic baggie, FTP cocaine residue, found in living room on tray (Detective Conaty)
- 13. Four new plastic baggies & one new larger plastic baggie in kitchen cabinet (Detective Conaty)

Concluding the search, detectives digitally filmed Daub's apartment and secured his damaged front door.

Daub sustained several minor abrasions while being detained and later complained of pain to his left shoulder. Patrol Officer Kenneth Beirbower, who accompanied Daub to Lower Keys Medical Center, requested paramedics after Daub complained of pain. Key West Fire-Rescue medics transported Daub the hospital for physician assessment.

Detective Malsheimer met with Daub at the hospital and issued him a mandatory Notice-to-Appear [in court] for possessing drug paraphernalia (FSS 893.147.1). Daub is to appear in front of the Honorable Judge Mark Wilson on January 22. 2019 at 9:00AM. Daub signed the NTA; Detective Malsheimer left him a copy.

Hennigan's syringe's residue did not test positive for narcotics. Consequently, I released Hennigan.

I left a copy of the search warrant on Daub's living room coffee table.

I left the original warrant and the Inventory and Returns forms with Deputy Clerk Janell Shirk on January 4, 2019.

Upon entering the residence, I made contact with a male who was later identified as Gary Daub (dob:06/07/1954). Daub was sitting on a couch that against on the East wall. I grabbed Daub's left arm and put it into a handcuff. I gave him several loud verbal commands to put his hands behind his back. Daub would not put his right arm behind his back, and Ofc. T. Mitchell grabbed his right arm. As we attempted to handcuff Daub, he started pulling his arms back and forth and pulling his body away. Ofc. T. Mitchell and I redirected Daub to the ground. Daub landed on his right side and curled up into a ball. Ofc. Chaustit assisted with placing Daub on the ground and I placed his other hand into the handcuffs.

This ends my involvement with this incident.

On 01/03/2019, at about 1730 hours, The Key West Police Department Special Response Team (SRT/SWAT) and the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) served a narcotics search warrant at 301 White Street, Apt. 12C (Porter Place).

Upon entering the residence, I (Ofc. T. Mitchell, SRT) saw that Ofc. N. Mogerly had made contact with a white male (Gary Allen Daub, DOB 06/07/1954). Daub was sitting on a couch along the East wall. Ofc. N. Mogerley had a hold of Daub's left arm and was giving him loud verbal commands place his hands behind his back. Daub did not comply and continued to remain seated on the couch with his free hand by his side. I grabbed a hold of Daub's right arm, and together Ofc. N. Mogerley and I attempted to stand Daub up to handcuff him. As we attempted to stand Daub up, he tensed his entire body and began to pull back and forth away from us. Ofc. N. Mogerley and I then redirected Daub to the ground. Once on the ground, Daub landed on his right side and curled into the fetal position. We continued to give Daub loud verbal commands to stop resisting and place his hands behind his back, however he did not comply, and continued to stiffen/tense his body and pull his arms/hands away.

Ofc. M. Chaustit attempted to assist by grabbing a hold of Daub's belt, lifting him up off the ground, and placing him onto his stomach. Once on his stomach, Daub tucked his right arm underneath him, rolled back onto his right side, and again failed to comply with our orders to place his hands behind his back. Ofc. M. Chaustit lifted Daub up a second time, placed him on his stomach, and delivered a closed fist strike to his buttocks. Daub then complied and placed his hands behind his back so that he could be handcuffed.

I then stood Daub up and escorted him outside where he remained with KWPD SIU Detectives.

On January 3, 2019, I was working as a member of the Key West Police Department Special Response Team. We were requested to serve a search warrant on a residence located at 301 White Street unit number 12C.

The Special Response Team arrived and made entry into the residence to execute the search warrant. I entered the residence and saw Ofc. T. Mitchell and Ofc. N. Mogerley attempting to take a white male later identified as Gary Daub into custody. Ofc. Mitchell and Ofc. Mogerley gave Daub loud verbal repetitive commands to put his hands behind his back. Daub refused to comply with their lawful commands and was pulling away from them and twisting his body from side to side. Daub rolled his body from side to side in an apparent effort to prevent Ofc. Mitchell and Ofc. Mogerley from handcuffing him.

I grabbed onto Daub's ankles and twisted his legs to force his body into the prone position and to prevent him from using his feet and legs to resist Ofc. Mitchell and Ofc. Mogerley. Daub continued to twist his upper body from side to side. I grabbed onto Daub's belt and lifted him about 12 to 18 inches off of the floor so he no longer had any leverage to resist Ofc. Mitchell and Ofc. Mogerley. Once Ofc. Mitchell and Ofc. Mogerley had control of Daub I lowered him back to the floor. Once Daub was on the ground, he rolled to his right side again. I delivered a closed hand strike to Daub's buttocks to gain compliance. Daub finally complied, Ofc. Mogerley and Ofc. Mitchell handcuffed him.

I conducted a quick visual check of the residence and saw the other occupant had been detained and residence was secure. I left the residence and left the scene after the scene was turned over to the special investigations unit.

On 1/3/19 at approximately 1907 hours, I was dispatched to 301-12C White street (Porter Place) in reference to a prisoner transport.

Upon arrival, I met with Sergeant B. Lariz, Detective H. Del Valle and other members of the KWPD Special Investigations Unit. Detective Del Valle was escorting Gary Daub out of the residence, after taking him into custody during the execution of a search warrant. Daub was complaining of an arm injury that he sustained during the arrest. Sergeant Lariz made the decision to have KWFR respond to the scene and evaluate Daub for his injury. While waiting for KWFR to respond, Daub informed me that he previously had surgery on his left shoulder and he felt like his shoulder and elbow were both injured. At approximately 1930 hours, KWFR arrived on scene and transported Daub to Lower Keys Medical Center for further evaluation. While at the hospital, it was determined that Daub's shoulder did not sustain any additional damage, but he did have a small break in his left elbow. It is unclear at this time if Daub sustained this injury during the arrest, or if the injury was from a previous event. While at the hospital, I took photos of Daubs injured elbow. Those photos have been uploaded to AXON.

After Daub was cleared from the hospital, He was issued an NTA and released.
