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On January 24, 2019, at approximately 0013 hours, I (Ofc Valdes Marrero) responded to 1129 Fleming St (Island House for Men) in reference to a trespasser and a verbal altercation. Dispatch advised there was a male subject refusing to leave the property and threatening staff members. Dispatch said the male had curly hair and was naked.

Upon arrival, Ofc Gillespie and myself met with the caller at the front desk. I activated my agency issued BWC (video was later uploaded to the server as evidence). The caller was the general manager for the property and he identified himself as Jeffrey Smead. Smead and another manager said there was a guest in room 103 that was being belligerent with the front desk personal and was possibly intoxicated. Front desk said they wanted police to speak with the subject (later identified as Joshua Kimrey per his PA DL) and have him quiet down to not disturb guests.

I was escorted to the room by the manager. I knocked on the room door and announced myself with Key West Police. Kimrey swung the room door open in an aggressive manner. Kimrey matched the description given by dispatch. I told Kimrey to step out of the room. I asked Kimrey what had happened and said he was being harassed by the front desk. Kimrey said he confronted the front desk about a disagreement they had.

As I was talking to Kimrey, I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. Kimrey had bloodshot and glassy eyes which are indicatives of alcohol consumption. Kimrey kept talking over me as I was explaining myself. Kimrey's demeanor was very hostile and was talking loudly. Kimrey assumed a "parade rest" position and said he was a military veteran. Kimrey continued arguing with me and continued to yell while disturbing other guests that were present in the area. I told Kimrey I was lawfully detaining him pending the outcome of a trespass and disorderly conduct investigation.

I stepped away to speak with Smead. Ofc Gillespie remained with Kimrey on front of his room. As I was talking with Smead about possible outcomes and solutions for the situation, Kimrey started jumping around and yelling loudly while walking away. I walked back to assist Ofc Gillespie in case the situation got out of hand. I tried talking with Kimrey but he would not listen to my commands to remain calm. Kimrey said he wanted to "escape the situation" as he was looking around for a place to run. I told Gillespie to grab Kimrey's left hand while I grabbed his right hand. I attempted to place Kimrey in handcuffs to avoid him fleeing from the scene and/or hurting himself due to his behavior. Kimrey refused to put his hand behind his back after I told him to do so multiple times. Kimrey was tensed up and kept pulling away from me several times to the point my body worn camera was knocked off my chest. Kimrey continued resisting and I decided to perform a take down maneuver in order to place Kimrey into custody.

While on the floor, Kimrey continued resisting by tensing up. After several attempts to place Kimrey into custody, Ofc Gillespie and I were able to handcuff him. I informed channel 1 of the response to resistance incident and asked for a supervisor. Ofc Gillespie and I lifted Kimrey up and transported him to my patrol vehicle. Kimrey continued resisting by pulling away as we were walking. Ofc Gillespie's body worn camera was knocked off several times while trying to control Kimrey. I placed Kimrey in the back of my patrol vehicle. Kimrey later mentioned he suffers from PTSD because he was prior airborne military.

I spoke with Smead and asked him if he wanted to press charges for the disorderly conduct and trespass after warning and he declined. Smead only wanted the subject trespass warned from the property.

I transported Kimrey to MCDC. On our way to MCDC, Kimrey's demeanor appeared to fluctuate from angry to sad a few times. Kimrey called me an array of names and referred to me a "private", which is a military term for the

lowest ranked officer. Once we arrived at MCDC, Ofc Gillespie, myself and other detention deputies transported Kimrey up in the elevator and into the booking center. On the elevator, Kimrey banged his head several times against the walls and continued to yell. Kimrey had to be placed in a restraint chair afterwards due to his aggressive behavior.

On January 24, 2019, I (Ofc Valdes Marrero) have probable cause to arrest Joshua Kimrey for violating F.S.S. 843.02 (Resist / Obstruct Officer w/o violence). Kimrey was lawfully detained pending the outcome of disorderly conduct and trespass investigation. Kimrey refused to comply with my commands to place his hands behind his back after being instructed to do so several times. Kimrey pulled away and tensed up several times as he was being handcuffed. Kimrey had to be taken to the ground in order to place him in handcuffs.

On 01/24/2019, at approximately 0004, I responded as a back up unit to 1129 Fleming St. unit C. (Island House for Men) in reference to a verbal disturbance.

Upon arrival, I entered the hotel behind Ofc. Valdes. We made contact with the hotel managers. They advised us that one of the males staying in room 103 had been making threats toward them and acting aggressively toward hotel guest. Ofc. Valdes and I walked to room 103 to make contact with the male.

Once we arrived at the room, we knocked and the male (Joshua Nathaniel Kimrey) exited the room. Almost immediately I observed Kimrey to have an aggressive posture, tensing his arms and clenching his fists. Kimrey was argumentative during the entire incident. Ofc. Valdes tried to explain why we were there talking to him and asked Kimrey what his side of the story was. Ofc. Valdes asked me to stay and watch Kimrey while conducted an investigation. I attempted to calm Kimrey by talking to him. Kimrey became more verbally aggressive, tensed his arms and body and grit his teeth. Throughout most of our interaction Kimrey spoke as if he were in the military and stood as if he were at attention. Kimrey was completely naked during the entire incident. Kimrey asked to go back into his room, Ofc. Valdes informed Kimrey that he was being detained and was not free to leave. Kimrey asked again to go back into his room, and Ofc. Valdes said that he could not go into his room at this point, Kimrey said "well we are going to have problems then". Kimrey said "I want to escape this situation" as he moved toward several other guests of the hotel that were in the nearby hot tub and the exit. Ofc. Valdes grabbed Kimrey's right arm and I grabbed his left arm and held him against the wall. I was able to get Kimrey's left arm behind his back, even though Kimrey continually tensed his arm and body. Ofc. Valdes had ahold of Kimrey's right arm and took him to the ground. Both Ofc. Valdes and Kimrey fell to the ground and I fell on top of them. While on the ground I was able to put Kimrey's left arm behind his back again. Ofc. Valdes placed Kimrey's right arm behind his back and then placed him into hand cuffs.

Kimrey would not walk out to Ofc. Valdes's patrol car, we had to carry him a portion of the way. After having to carry Kimrey for several steps, Kimrey started to walk on his own. Kimrey acted aggressively the entire ride out to MCDC and throughout the entire time he was being evaluated by the jail nurse.

I activated my BWC during this incident.

I have no further information at the time of this report.///END OF REPORT///
