A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY CHURCH AND ONE HUMAN FAMILY TO CONDUCT THE QUEEN MOTHER PAGEANT ON MONDAY, MAY 13, 2019 AT LA TE DA 1125 DUVAL STREET FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 10:30 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 1100 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 10:30 P.M; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 8:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M (SOUND CHECK AT 4:00 P.M. TO 5:00 P.M); AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family wishes to conduct the Queen Mother Pageant as a fundraiser for Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family is hereby granted permission to conduct a fundraiser on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family is hereby granted permission for the closure of the 1100 block of Duval from 7:00 a.m. to 10:30 P.M., provided, however, that the special event shall end at 10:30 P.M. and the street may be closed until midnight while the stage is dismantled.

SECTION 3. That Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family. is hereby

granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinance the Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. The Metropolitan Community Church and One Human Family will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
