On Thursday, March 28, 2019 at 2:00 AM, KWPD officers were dispatched to Wing Masters at 934 Truman Avenue for a physical disturbance. The reporting party told Key West Dispatch there were two males and one female fighting.

Sergeant Siracuse was the first to arrive on scene. Bystanders pointed Sergeant Siracuse toward one of the involved parties, Martin Perry. Sergeant Siracuse gave Perry multiple orders to stop, i.e.," Stop, Police!", "Stop or you're going to get tased". Perry ignored Sergeant Siracuse's orders and continued to walk away. Sergeant Siracuse grabbed Perry by his right arm. Perry pulled away, at which point Sergeant Siracuse tased him. After the tasing, Sergeant Siracuse was able to detain Perry.

Perry's wife, Tammy Paul, who was the female involved, told me a Hispanic male with a red and white shirt and dark jeans started fighting with Perry for no reason. Tammy later told us the Hispanic male lives next door to them but neither of them know his name. Sergeant Siracuse advised the Hispanic male fled south on White Street.

A bartender, Michael Ponnath, from Don's Place at 1000 Truman told us earlier in the night he observed Perry causing issues with multiple people in the area. Michael told us he observed Perry going after someone with a bottle in his hand. Michael said he slapped the bottle out of Perry's hand.

Perry had a bloody mouth and swollen cheek from the physical disturbance we were dispatched to. I rode with Key West Rescue and Perry to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance. Once cleared, I transported Perry to the Monroe County Detention Center and turned him over to the detention deputies without incident.

Perry did violate F.S.S. 843.02 RESISTING OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE TO HIS OR HER PERSON by walking away from Sergeant Siracuse, ignoring Sergeant Siracuse's orders, and pulling away when Sergeant Siracuse grabbed his arm while Sergeant Siracuse was engaged in the legal process of detaining Perry for being involved in a physical disturbance. At the time, Sergeant Siracuse was a police officer. Branden should have known he was a police officer as he identified himself as such and was dressed in his police uniform.

Perry did also violate F.S.S. 877.03 BREACH OF PEACE; DISSORDERLY CONDUCT by engaging in brawling and fighting as witnessed by several witnesses in this incident. I also observed abrasions and swelling to Perry's knuckles, evident of wounds which could have been sustained in a fight.

On 3/28/19 at approximately 0200 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to a large physical disturbance across from Don's Place near Wingmasters' restaurant.

Upon arrival, I observed a large crowd in the street and numerous witnesses pointed southbound on Grinnell Street. I noticed they were mostly pointing at a black male, later identified as Martin Perry, who was initially walking southbound on Grinnell. I activated my emergency lights and got out of my marked patrol vehicle. I was wearing my class B KWPD uniform and I activated my BWC.

I observed Perry turn and begin walking quickly northbound on the sidewalk. I saw Perry was bleeding from the mouth and hands and it was clear to me he was involved in the fight. I attempted to stop Perry as he walked toward the apartments above Wingmasters.

I gave Perry multiple clear, loud, verbal commands to stop. Perry ignored my commands and continued walking away from me. A witness yelled "You better call for backup," and others tried to tell Perry to stop. I again yelled, "Police, stop or you're going to get tased," but Perry continued walking. Perry was a large black male with dreadlocks, approximately 6 feet tall and 200 lbs. I grabbed Perry's right arm and told him again to stop. Perry ripped his arm out of my hand and continued walking.

I deployed my Taser and both prongs entered the front right side of Perry's abdomen. Perry fell to the ground and once the Taser finished cycling, I ordered Perry to roll over and place his hands behind his back. Perry complied. I knelt on Perry's back, holstered my Taser, and handcuffed him. I informed dispatch I had one subject tased and requested backup as well as rescue.

Perry was placed in an ambulance and later treated for his injuries at the ER. Officer Haynie rode with rescue to the ER and completed the arrest affidavit for Perry. On scene, I photographed Perry's injuries and the original location of the fight. I also met with two independent witnesses (Michael Ponnath and Mashayla Reede) and gathered their information for the RRI. Sgt. Rodriguez arrived on scene to assist with the RRI. The witnesses stated Perry was out of control and had engaged in a fight above Wingmasters as well as attempted to attack someone in the back bar of Don's Place with a bottle.

My BWC, in car Coban video, and Taser cam were all activated for the incident.

I had Ofc. C. Purcell place my Taser cartridge and Afid into the KWPD property and evidence section.
