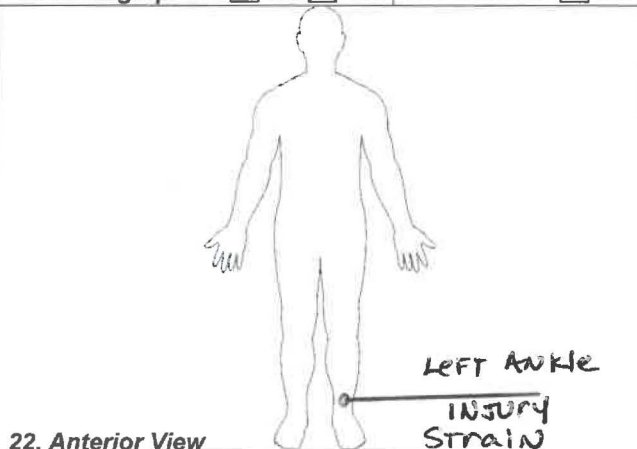

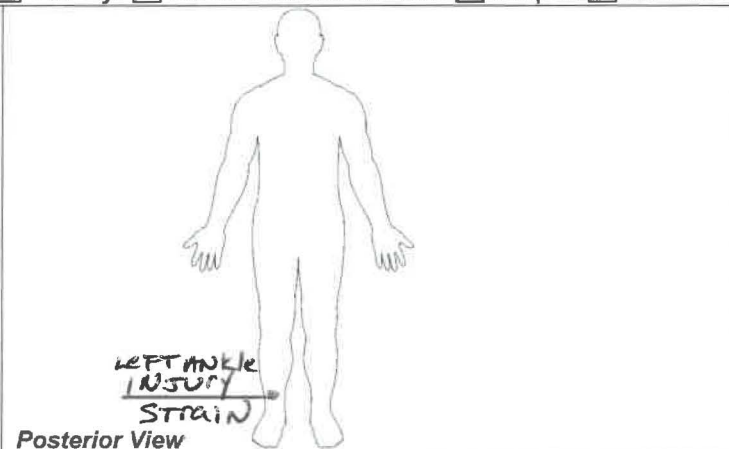

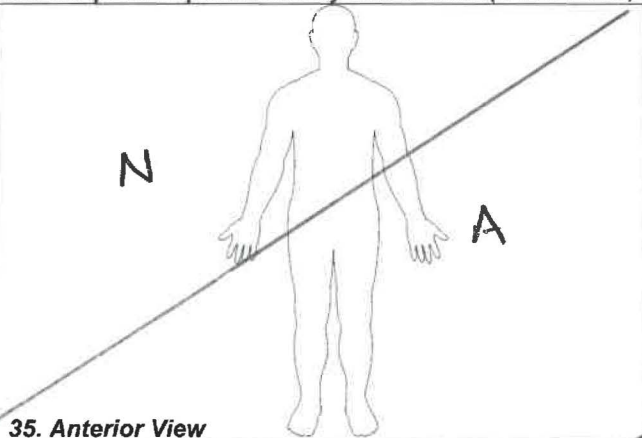

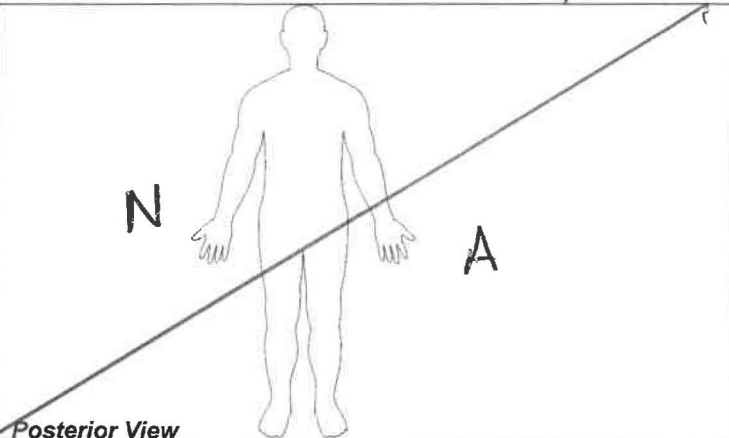

On 03.28.19 at approximately 1228 hours, I, Ofc. Carter Sims was at 1105 Leon St., the HOB School, as I was acting in the capacity of a School Resource Officer. I was typing a report from a previous call, which had occurred at HOB. All of the sudden, an employee in the Front Office tells me I may want to go outside, as there was some type of disturbance.

I walk out of the Front Office and onto the sidewalk, look to my right, and see Christina McPherson and another woman, following someone walking north along the sidewalk. This direction was from the school towards N Roosevelt Blvd. I could her McPherson calling me over the school radio about a possible Signal 20- Mentally Disturbed Person. I began walking toward McPherson and could clearly hear her calling out, "[REDACTED] stop!" I later found out the other person walking in front of them was, [REDACTED] a 7th grade student.

After I passed the rear entrance to the Police Department, I began jogging to McPherson, because she said [REDACTED] may run out into traffic. When I caught up to McPherson, I confirmed [REDACTED]'s name, and the fact she may run out into traffic. Having nothing else to go on, I continued to jog until I got to [REDACTED]. Mind you, I had been calling out to her, by name, and telling her to stop. During this time, I activated by AXON BWC. I did not yell loudly, but loud enough I know she heard me. I was afraid [REDACTED] would start running and I would not be able to catch her before she ran into traffic. She was not wearing any headphones.

[REDACTED] continued walking North along the sidewalk nearing N Roosevelt Blvd. She would not stop walking, even after McPherson and myself asked her several times to stop. [REDACTED] was wearing a small backpack/purse with straps over both shoulders. With one of my hands, I grabbed the handle on the purse in an attempt to stop [REDACTED]. She threw her shoulders back and this caused the backpack to come off, and I let it fall to the ground.

Then, with my left hand, I grabbed the hoodie portion of her sweatshirt, and began pulling back. Again, in an attempt to not let her run into traffic, based on what McPherson had told me.

[REDACTED] displayed the following: Active Physical Resistance- a person makes physically evasive movements to defeat an officer's attempt at control. [REDACTED] shrugged her shoulders after I grabbed the backpack; then she continued to try and walk away after I grabbed the hoodie on her sweatshirt. While pulling her back, she was digging her feet into the ground as if she was going to continue in a forward motion.

I responded with the following Officer Response Option: Level One: Physical Control- Take Down: a technique that redirects, in a controlled manner, a person to the ground to limit his/her physical resistance and to apply an appropriate restraint device. As I was grabbing the hoodie with my left hand and pulling back, I raised my right foot. After I raised my foot, I did a front kick to the top of [REDACTED] left calf. This caused her knee to fold as it normally would, and she fell backwards onto her butt. At this time, Officer Danny Blanco arrived on scene. I asked him to assist me in handcuffing [REDACTED] to prevent any other incidents.

I notified Sgt. Frank Duponty on the radio that I had a Response to Resistance Incident. In addition, I asked for Key West Fire Rescue to respond, because [REDACTED] was complaining of pain and soreness in her left ankle. KWFD Rescue #2 responded to the scene. Sgt. Duponty and KWFD Rescue #2 arrived on scene shortly after they were notified. [REDACTED] was not very cooperative, but eventually got on a stretcher and was put in the ambulance. Sgt. Duponty spoke with her about what had happened and why she did what she did. [REDACTED] told him she was only trying to get to her therapist office so she could talk with him. [REDACTED] said she was never going to walk out into to traffic to harm herself.
