A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE FLORIDA, KEY WEST, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(3)(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF TWO SURPLUS AND OBSOLETE INTERNATIONAL VACTOR SEWER CLEANING VEHICLES IN EXCHANGE FOR A TRADE-IN ALLOWANCE OF \$50,000.00 TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF A 2019 CLEANING TRUCK FROM **ENVIRONMENTAL** PRODUCTS OF FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 18-370 the City Commission approved the purchase of a 2019 Vactor sewer cleaning truck, with the purchase price including a trade-in allowance of \$50,000.00 in exchange for two city-owned Vactor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined it is in the City's best interests pursuant to section 2-771(3)(c) of the Code of Ordinances, and recommends City Commission approval of the tradein of two surplus and obsolete Vactor sewer cleaning vehicles, in exchange for \$50,000.00 credit toward the purchase of a 2019 sewer cleaning truck, as described in Resolution 18-370; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of two surplus and obsolete city-owned Vactor vehicles, as described in the attached executive summary, in exchange for a trade allowance of \$50,000.00 toward the purchase of a 2019 Vactor 2100 Plus CSC Machine, approved in Resolution 18-370, pursuant to section 2-771(c) is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That the City Manager, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to complete the transactions.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
