The city commission shall have authority by resolution to correct any omissions, errors or mistakes in the entry of liens in the demolition and removal lien book until such time as said liens are transferred to the assessment roll, after which time any such omissions, errors or mistakes may be corrected only by resolution of the city commission.

Section 7. This act is severable in its provisions and the adjudicated invalidity of any part shall not affect the remainder.

Section 8. All laws or parts of laws, whether general, special or local, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 9. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

N. ACT prescribing the territorial limits of the municipality known as Kissimmee in Osceola County.

It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The boundaries of the city of Kissimmee in sceola County shall be as follows:
