A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSIT WEB-BASED PLANNING SOFTWARE SERVICES FROM REMIX SOFTWARE, INC. ("REMIX"), AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED PROPOSAL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,000.00 PER YEAR, FOR UP TO THREE YEARS, ON A SOLE SOURCE BASIS, AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(1) AND 2-797(4)(b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) permits the purchase of goods and services without competition on a sole source basis under certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this Remix web-based software program will satisfy the City's needs, and that Remix is the sole source provider of this proprietary system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the procurement of web-based Remix Public Transit software for a period of up to three years, as set forth in the attached price quote from Remix, is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$17,000.00 per year (a total of \$51,000 over three years), pursuant to Code of Ordinances Section 2-797(1), sole source procurement, and Section 2-797(4)(b), best interests of the City.

Section 2: This purchase will be funded up to 50% through the FDOT Service Development Grant (reimbursed to Cost Center 11) for the first year, and anticipated funding through the U.S.C. Section 5331 Formula Grants for Rural Areas Program administered by the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the second and third year. The first year of service will be funded through the Transportation Alternative Fund 111 at \$17,000.00, and subsequent years will be funded through the Transit Fund 411 at \$17,000.00 per year, and any necessary budget adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the City of Key West.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
