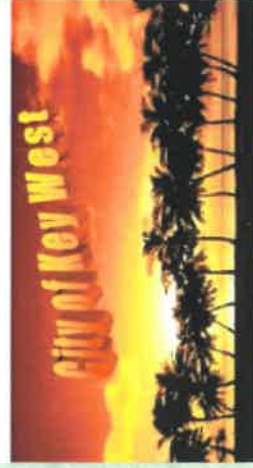

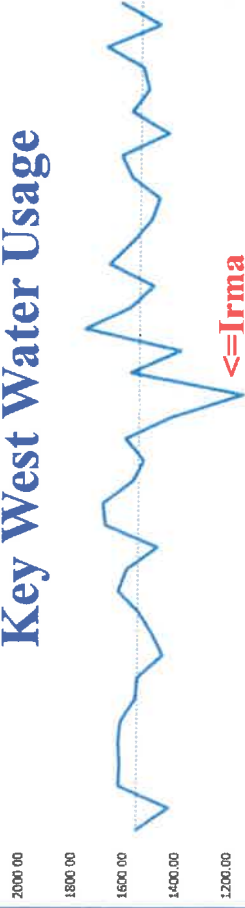

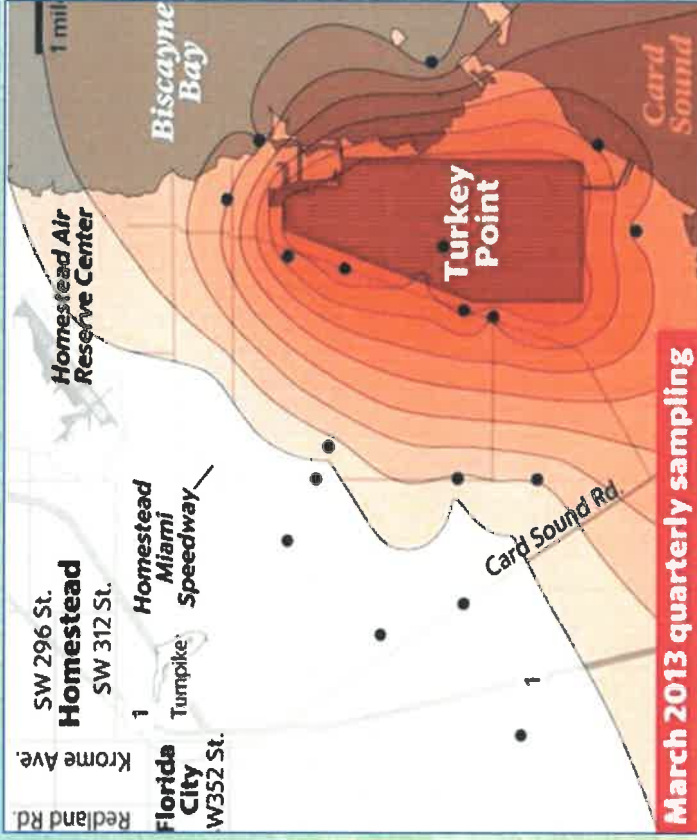

BPAS: Friendly Amendments

Cisterns Provide:

- 1) Potable Water Conservation
- 2) Stormwater Reduction
- 3) Water Quality Protection
- 4) Hurricane Resilience

WIN

Rethinking Stormwater Systems:

- Cisterns: Vertical/Below Ground
- Swales: Horizontal, at Ground

Which provides more space ?

d. Applicants may request exemption from cisterns, if:

- (i) The applicant is pursuing points for providing **50%** affordable units at median or low-income classification.
- (ii) The applicant seeks to create accessory unit(s) on a property that is at or in exceedance of maximum building coverage and/or impervious surface ratio, and the applicant pays into the Stormwater Fund **\$2 per gallon in mitigation** for the size of cistern exempted.

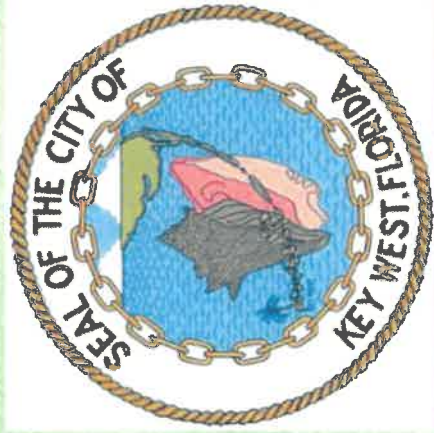

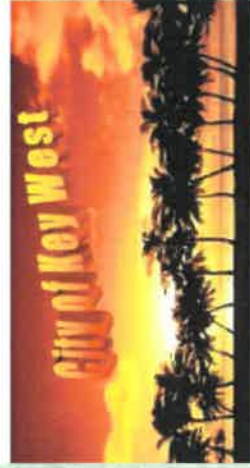
