Tree Species: Strangler Fig (Ficus aurea)

























Diameter: 38.2"

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To the Owner of Property at 2119 Flagler Ave.,

A while back, I spoke to you about the Strangler Fig tree in your yard that was growing rapidly and close to my house. I let you know that I was having the tree trimmed (by Golden Bough Tree Service) away from the roof (my roof) and lower branches away from my house.

As time has gone by, the tree has grown aggressively. The trunk of the tree is butting right up against my house, the corner of my house, and the roots are clearly growing along the <u>foundation</u> of my house!! The damage is going to happen!! It is now just a matter of time. Tree removal is costly but repairs to my house caused by the tree will be MAJOR.

This requires your IMMEDIATE ATTENTION. I have spoken to Karen DeMaria, with the City Tree Commission, about the **Urgent Situation**. I was told that you as property owners and as OWNER of the TREE you must:

- Fill out 2 Forms
- Have 1 Form notarized (can also be done @ City Hall)
- Attend Tree Commission meeting- upon approval to Remove Tree

I have spoken with Golden Bough Tree service and he is going to give me an estimate on cost of removal of the tree.

This matter requires your IMMEDIATE ATTENTION. There is no way around this, the tree needs to be removed before <u>costly damage to my house</u> occurs. I have spoken to your tenants but have not been able to catch you at home. Please contact me and let me know your intentions.

I have inspected the strangler fig tree and the area where it is currently growing. The tree is primarily on your property, therefore, you are the responsible party for the tree. It appear the tree is impacting your neighbor's house as the roots are running along the base of the wall and at least one longitudinal crack could be seen going up the wall. Also, the base of the tree is currently growing at the base to the house structure and the potential damage will only worsen with time.

I recommend you allow the processing of the application to remove the tree. Removal will have to be reviewed by the Tree Commission and the next meeting would be June 11. Someone must attend the meeting to represent the tree and/or the property. Right now you are the only one that can do that as you are the owner of the tree. If you can not attend the meeting or do not want to attend, then please fill out the attached letter of representation form. You can have anyone attend the meeting on behalf of the tree- your neighbor, a friend, an arborist. I need that form signed and notarized in order to complete processing of the application.
