### START OF CONSTRUCTION AND CONTRACT COMPLETION TIME

The Bidder agrees to begin work within fourteen (14) calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed and to fully complete all work under this contract within one hundred-fifty (150) calendar days, including construction of the foundation and assembly of the structure.

### LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In the event the Bidder is awarded the Contract and fails to complete the work within the time limit or extended time limit agreed upon, as more particularly set forth in the Contract Documents, liquidated damages shall be paid to the Owner at the rate of **\$1,000.00** per day for all work awarded until the work has been satisfactorily completed as provided by the Contract Documents. Sundays and legal holidays shall be excluded in determining days in default.

Owner will recover such liquidated damages by deducting the amount owed from the final payment or any retainage held by Owner.

# **Sampling of Project Experience**



### Villa de Marco West Marco Island, Florida

Phase I of the project consisted of installing a 365 linear ft. cantilever steel sheet pile (SSP) wall with a concrete curtain wall and cap replacing the concrete seawall obliterated during Hurricane Irma. The Z-profile SSPs, ranging in length from 40' to 52', were installed to top of rock; damaged piers, concrete blocks, landscaping, and other hurricane debris were removed from the alignment. Once the seawall was secured, a 2' deep x 4' tall concrete curtain wall, spanning the tidal zone, was poured along the entire face followed by a 3' x 2.5' concrete cap. Additionally, a 40 linear ft. section of SSP toe wall was constructed 20' below water for scour counter measures. An engineered cathodic protection system was installed consisting of 34, 240 lb. aluminum anodes welded along the seawall face and toe wall. During all SSP installation the exposed building was monitored for vibrations and observed for settlement by a third-party surveyor. The steel sheet piles were successfully driven into place without causing any added duress on the already precarious structures.

Phase II of the project, currently underway, consists of filling in behind the new seawall with locally dredged sand, rebuilding the fishing pier and resident finger docks, along with restoring a 12,000 sq. ft. area in front of the seawall with fill and securing it with armor mat for scour protection. Timber dock and mooring piles ranging from 25 linear ft. to 50 linear ft. will be installed in their previous footprint with all new composite decking. The fishing pier located at the point will encompass grout filled steel pipe piles wrapped with HDPE sleeves, composite decking, IPE railing, ADA accessible ramps and viewpoints, and a fish cleaning table.

### Chokoloskee Bridge Everglades City, Florida

Kelly Brothers (KBI) replaced the existing bridge to Chokoloskee Island with a new wider structure measuring 225' long x 52' wide. KBI worked with Collier County to provide an initial Cost Savings Initiative (CSI) in excess of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).The total length of the project including the approach work is 1,100'. The new bridge has two (2) 12' wide travel lanes with 8' wide shoulders on each side and a single 8' sidewalk on the east (bay) side. The existing water main was relocated below the channel by means of directional bore. 

### Mangrove Bay, Phase II Naples, Florida

Kelly Brothers (KBI) continued work on Phase II of Mangrove Bay's waterfront improvements. This phase included demolition, mangrove removal, and nearly 900 cubic yards of dredging. Furthermore, the installation work of this 2<sup>nd</sup> phase included approximately 735 linear ft. of concrete seawall with 160 ton of riprap installed at toe of the seawall panels, fixed docks, a floating dock and gangway, as well as boat and kayak ramps.

The concrete seawall is comprised of  $8'' \times 4'$ -6'' panels, an  $8'' \times 10''$  waler, and a 2' x 2' cap topped with an 8" thick knee wall, which varies in elevation. The single and double-sided continuous deadman were surveyed into position with 10" square concrete piles driven beneath them prior to pouring concrete. Particular emphasis on survey for each seawall component was taken to prevent obstruction of future foundation pilings. The seawall also includes a radius backfilled with imported fill, extending the upland out an additional 76 ft. for an overall property gain of 3,536 sq. ft.

The docking facilities include 2600 sq. ft. of fixed docks with PT decking and pile strips along with a community designated fixed dock, which is 380 sq. ft. and includes a 65 linear ft. ADA compliant ramp connected to a 30' long aluminum gangway leading to a 300 sq. ft. aluminum floating dock supported by three 14" square by 30' long FDOT concrete pilings. In addition, a 56' x 12' kayak launch was constructed using 57 stone and articulating block mat. Denso 400 and 500 pile jackets were furnished and installed.
