Re: June Monthly Report for Key West Historic Seaport

Key West Bight Operations:

• Ferry Terminal Pier Extension is complete.

- Preparing ITB for new pipe mooring piles at the Ferry Terminal Pier.
- Preparing ITB for the Seaports fire main replacement.
- Preparing ITB for Ferry Terminal Portable Generator installation.
- Contractor for Conch Republic, Schooner Wharf and Turtle Kraals Seawall Replacement project to go before the CRA on July 16, 2019.
- Margaret St Bathhouse/ Laundry Repairs under review as it has exceeded FEMA's 50% rule. Expecting building permit this month.
- Additional granite stone to be delivered for planter beds.

Key West Bight Marina:

- June transient dockage was up 17% compared to last June.
- This year our mini lobster season week is from July 22 to July 25 we still have a couple slips open.
- Starting our summer maintenance program checking all water fixtures throughout the marina.
- Checked all cleats on A dock and C dock.
- Checked pump out fixtures on A dock and C dock.
- 11,851 Passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this June compared to 12,482 last June.
- The Ferry Terminal fuel system was shut down at the end of April because of a pipe rusting through below ground allowing water to enter the annular space of the in ground tank. Repairs were completed June 6th.
- The Yankee Freedom is again fueling at the ferry terminal.
