AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 70 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES" BY AMENDING
ARTICLE IV - "PARKING STOPPING AND STANDING",
DIVISION 6, "EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PARKING
PERMIT PROGRAM IN HISTORIC DISTRICT",
AMENDING SECTION 70-255 TO ADJUST EMPLOYEE
ASSISTANCE PARKING DECAL FEES; PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF
INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Employee Assistance Parking
Permit ordinance will promote the health, safety and welfare of
the citizens and visitors of the City of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST,
FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 70-255 of the Code of
Ordinances is hereby amended as follows*:

Sec. 70-255. - Program; costs; reclamation.

Decals shall be valid for four months and shall cost ~~\$480.00~~
~~tax included~~ \$700.00 plus sales tax. All employee assistance
parking decals are considered property of the City of Key West.
Fees are nonrefundable and not pro-rated. All expired decals must
be returned to the City of Key West Parking Collections Division
prior to the issuance of a renewal decal.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or
application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional
for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the
remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable
therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to
achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said
City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby
superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately
upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature
of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
